Thanks for talking with me today. As I explained, the issue of concern was associated with the second round of testing of mysid chronic tests that are required by the BP Agreed Order 20840. The third cooler containing the last renewal sample for the second mysid test was delayed in shipping and arrived approximately 48 hours after the sampling event; so outside the typical 36hr window by about 12hrs. The samples were still at an acceptable temperature upon arrival and were used to finish the testing. This was an unusual situation and was due to shipping issues (we've all been there). My understanding from our conversation today is that this test would meet the requirements for the Agreed Order and that there would be no need to repeat the test this quarter. I appreciate your assistance and understanding in addressing this issue.
