Dear Alfonso Cisneros:

This letter is to inform you that your facility is out of compliance with your industrial wastewater discharge permit. Violations are listed in Tables 1 and 2.

Non-compliance notifications are required by your permit. You must submit this notice immediately. You have not submitted a written notice of non-compliance for the violations in **Table 1**, therefore you are in violation of your permit. You may refer to **permit section S3.E.** for more information about what must be included in a written notice of non-compliance. The written notice of non-compliance should address the source(s) of the violations and how you are going to take action to prevent future violations. From this point forward, the notice of non-compliance and an electronic copy of the **laboratory report** should be attached to every discharge monitoring report (DMR) submission.

Three of the reports required by your permit are past due (**Table 2**). Although a draft version of the O&M Manual was submitted to Ecology on May 31, 2022, the final version is still due. Failure to comply with the conditions of your permit may result in formal administrative enforcement action, including orders and penalties. Ecology's enforcement authority for state waste discharge permits is governed by Chapter 173-216 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC).
