Re: Kitsap County's S4.F Notification (WAR 045546):
Sheen discharge to Sinclair Inlet

Dear Mr. Nelson,

Ecology has received Kitsap County's (County) S4.F.1 notification for the notification listed above. This notification was submitted to Ecology through the Water Quality WebPortal to comply with the NPDES Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit (Permit) on January 26, 2024.

On January 8, 2024, Kitsap County Public Work (KCPW) staff received a complaint of a sheen spill on Dill Way W in Bremerton. After an inspection it was discovered that the sheen originated from a private residence driveway where work on vehicles had previously been performed. The sheen flowed down Dill Way W, entered County stormwater catch basins and subsequently into Sinclair Inlet. All impacted catch basins were vacuumed out and all impacted roadways were cleaned through use of oil-absorbent booms and pads. KCPW staff followed up with the responsible party to ensure that they understand best practices for ensuring vehicle fluids do not enter the stormwater system. This incident was reported to Ecology per ERTS 727866 on the day of the incident.

Ecology has determined that an adaptive management response under condition S4.F.3 is not necessary for this notification because the Phase II Permit's Stormwater Management Program requirements are designed to address illicit discharges into the MS4. The relevant requirement is S5.C.5 of the Ph II MS4 Permit. This determination does not affect any obligation you may have under other laws.
