Subject: Compliance Task Status Report (ZYK Enterprises, State Waste Discharge Permit #ST0003974)

The following report is a status update for Compliance Task 3 and 4.a in ZYK Enterprises' permit compliance schedule, which includes the following:

3	After review of current practices the consulting engineer shall make recommendations on improvements to operations to eliminate continued permit limit violations. This may include additional treatment prior to disinfection. Recommendations shall be made in a written report following the requirements of 173-240-150 WAC that must also be provided to Ecology for review.
4.a	Hire a contractor as needed to make/install any material/equipment modifications.

Pacific Stormwater submitted a Wastewater Management Options Analysis on behalf of ZYK Enterprises to Ecology on December 22, 2023. An analysis of the cost, footprint, efficacy, constructability, and permitting requirements determined that treatment using solids removal and an evaporator would be the best option for ZYK. Additionally, a schedule of construction and installation was included in the Options Analysis.

Installation of wastewater treatment is pending review by Ecology and permitting with King County. The environmental review and permitting department of King County has been contacted via



phone, email, and in person many times in Q4 2023 and Q1 2024 to determine which permits may be necessary for work on the shoreline of the Snoqualmie River. The County has not responded.
