The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is pleased to announce that we have a *new* secure on-line system for submitting your Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR). We encourage you to participate in this new, improved option for submitting DMRs. This new system, called WQWebDMR, provides instant feedback by reviewing and identifying any missing reports, benchmark exceedances, and other information to the permit holder on each submitted DMR data. Submitting your DMRs electronically will:

- Allow for 24/7 access.
- Create more efficient and timely submittals.
- Save paper and mailing expenses.
- Provide confirmation that Ecology has received your DMR submittal.
- Provide instant quality assurance review and feedback upon submittal.
