Re: Extension of NPDES Wastewater Permits for Marine Net Pens

Dear Mr. Woodruff:

Your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permits for Marine Salmon Net Pens have an expiration date of October 26, 2012. Your applications for the renewal permits were received on April 25, 2012 and accepted as complete on June 7, 2012.

In accordance with the Washington State Administrative procedures Act (RCW 34.05.422(3)) and the Washington State Pollution Control Act (90.48.180), your current permits and terms and conditions are administratively extended. The extended permits are effective for a term of five years from the expiration date of the current permits, or until Ecology issues new permits, whichever occurs first.

The permit fees are subject to the same previous fee schedule. Permit fee billing will be in a separate mailing from the Ecology Permit Fee Unit.


