Dear Peter Whiting:

This letter is to notify you that the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) has updated our records: your facility covered under Permit WAG994368 does **not** discharge to a Puget Sound Sediment Cleanup Site as defined by the BYGP, so the permit requirements in Special Condition S2.E.3 do **not** apply to your facility. As such, the previously listed sampling and effluent limit for Total Suspended Solids (TSS) on your BYGP coverage has been removed from our PARIS Database and your Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) in the Water Quality Portal.

In addition, this correction also means that your facility **does not need to** “remove accumulated solids from storm drain lines (including inlets, catch basins, sumps, conveyances lines, and oil/water separators) on or beneath your facility at least once in the term of the permit.” Per Condition S2.3(a)ii(2). You can find a copy of the Final 2022 BYGP, permit forms, and other information at Ecology’s [Boatyard general permit webpage](https://ecology.wa.gov/Regulations-Permits/Permits-certifications/Boatyard-general-permit)<sup>1</sup>.
