**RE: You Must Reapply for your Industrial Stormwater General Permit – Third Reminder**

Dear Bruce Chambers:

Your facility is covered under Ecology's Industrial Stormwater General Permit (ISGP), which will expire on December 31, 2024. The ISGP requires you to reapply for permit coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the current permit (General Condition G8). You must reapply for the ISGP by **July 5, 2024, in order to maintain your permit coverage beyond the expiration date.**

If you fail to reapply for the ISGP, your permit coverage will terminate on December 31, 2024, when the current permit expires. If your permit is terminated and you discharge pollutants to waters of the State, you will violate the federal Clean Water Act and Chapter 90.48 RCW. **If you have already submitted a renewal application, please disregard this additional notice.**

To determine whether a renewal application was submitted for your permit, please visit <https://fortress.wa.gov/ecy/paris/PermitSearch.aspx> and search by entering the permit number or project name. Scroll down and a 'draft' application should appear in the list of search results (see 'Permit Status' column). Ecology will notify you if any additional information is required.

**To Reapply Online**

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) uses SecureAccess Washington (SAW) to maintain security of your data. ### **If You Need to Make Changes to Your Permit Coverage**

However, you may **not make** changes to the permittee affiliation in this renewal process. ### **Permit Reissuance**

Ecology is in the process of updating and reissuing the current ISGP. The draft 2024 ISGP has been released for public review and comment.
