The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed and APPROVES the City of Spokane (Spokane) CROMERR - Electronic Reporting Plan received by this office on December 13, 2021. The reporting change is a substantial modification to the delegated pretreatment program, in accordance with Title 40 CFR §403.18. The electronic reporting requirement is to be incorporated in to the Industrial Users control mechanism. This approval is in accordance with RCW 90.48.110 and Chapter 173-240 WAC.

Spokane must notify this office immediately of any proposed changes or revisions to the approved documents. Spokane must provide changes or revisions in the form of addenda, technical appendices, or supplemental reports to the original approved package of documents to Ecology for review and approval. Additionally, Spokane must maintain copies of the approved report, plans and specifications, operations and maintenance manual, permit, and Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) on-site at your facility in Spokane, Washington.

Ecology's review and approval of these documents only assures compliance and consistency with the appropriate rules, regulations, guidelines, planning and design criteria, terms of any loan agreement, and/or other similar documents and is not a quality control check. Spokane should not consider this approval as satisfying other applicable federal, state or local statutes, ordinances or regulations.


