

Background

Ecology is reviewing the Central Wastewater Treatment Plant (CWWT) NPDES permit for the first time since 2018. The Central WWTP, located in the part of Tacoma on Commencement Bay, treats sewage from homes and businesses, as well as industrial wastewater generated within the political jurisdictions of Tacoma, Puyallup, Milton, Pierce, Kitsap, Lewis County and King County.

The draft Permit establishes conditions the Central WWTP must meet to legally discharge treated wastewater to Puget Sound. Collectively, the updated requirements in the draft permit establish the minimum standards city of Tacoma must meet to protect water quality.

The draft permit includes requirements related to the following topics:

- limits on the amount of pollutants the city of Tacoma may discharge
- monitoring and reporting of wastewater discharges
- operation and maintenance of wastewater treatment and collection facilities
- responding to permit violations
- controlling industrial wastewater before it enters the sewage system

The Permit itself explains the legal basis for Ecology's decisions about the requirements in the draft permit. This includes describing the standards we apply and how we calculate numerical limits on pollutants.

NFL schedule gives Chiefs, Jets major exposure

The Kansas City Chiefs will open the season with a difficult one-two punch as they seek their third Super Bowl championship in a row.

The NFL released its full regular-season schedule on Wednesday night, when the Chiefs got a full look at the challenges in store for them in 2024. They will face Lamar Jackson and the Baltimore Ravens in the NFL's "Kickoff Game" on Sept. 5, and one week later they will play a Cincinnati Bengals team that has beaten them in six of the past eight regular-season matchups.

Plenty of other tests await the Chiefs, such as a road contest on Oct. 20 against the San Francisco 49ers in a rematch of last season's Super Bowl.

In other highlights from the schedule release, Aaron Rodgers and the New York Jets learned that they will be in prime time six times this season. The Jets' national slate includes a Week 1 matchup against the 49ers on

"Monday Night Football," another Monday night matchup in Week 6 against the Buffalo Bills, and a Week 9 game against the Houston Texans on Amazon's Thursday night schedule.

Rodgers and the Jets also will travel to London, where they will kick off against the Minnesota Vikings in Week 5 at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium.

The league's international schedule includes four other matchups. The Green Bay Packers and Philadelphia Eagles will face off on Sept. 6 in Sao Paulo, Brazil, in what will be the NFL's first regular-season game to be played in South America.

Two more London games feature the Jacksonville Jaguars vs. the Chicago Bears on Oct. 13 and the New England Patriots vs. the Jaguars on Oct. 20, and the final international game showcases the New York Giants vs. the Carolina Panthers on Nov. 10 in Munich, Germany.

The NFL again will play three games on Thanksgiving. The action starts with No. 1 overall pick

Caleb Williams and the Bears visiting the Detroit Lions, and it continues with a mid-afternoon matchup between the Giants and Dallas Cowboys. The nightcap features the Miami Dolphins at Green Bay.

One day later, on "Black Friday," the Las Vegas Raiders will visit Kansas City. This marks the second year that the NFL has broadcast a game on the day after Thanksgiving.

On Dec. 8, Kirk Cousins will visit a familiar environment when his Atlanta Falcons travel to play the Vikings. Cousins left Minnesota during free agency in the offseason to sign with the Vikings, who guaranteed him \$100 million and surprised him weeks later by selecting fellow quarterback Michael Penix Jr. with their first-round draft pick.

The schedule also includes a pair of games on Christmas Day, a Wednesday, that will air on Netflix — a first-time broadcast partnership for the NFL. The streaming service will feature the Chiefs vs. the Pittsburgh Steelers and the Ravens vs. the Texans.

"We couldn't be more excited to be the first professional sports league to partner with Netflix to bring live games to fans around the world," said Hans Schroeder, NFL's executive vice president of media distribution.

Francisco 49ers on Thursday Oct. 10.

Six of the Seahawks' first nine games are home. That includes four home games in five weeks immediately before their bye.

The flip side: Five of their last eight are on the road.

Seattle is on the road for three of its first four games following the team's bye in November.

Seattle's other prime-time games are, subject to the NFL's flex scheduling for that part of the season: a Sunday night home game Dec. 15 against Green Bay and the day after Christmas, Thursday night Dec. 26 at Chicago.

The Seahawks have never played on Christmas Day. This year will be the first time the team has been on a road trip on Christmas Day since 2010, part of a trip to play that holiday season at Tampa Bay.

The games at the Bears and at the division rival Los Angeles Rams either Jan. 4 or 5 end the regular season.

The NFL will announce the day and time of Seattle's regular-season finale at the Rams following the week 17 games.

LOTS OF MILES. AS ALWAYS

The Seahawks, because of geography, will again be among the most-traveled NFL teams. Seattle will fly 25,797 miles in the coming season, crossing back and forth across time zones 28 times for eight

regular-season road games. That will be the third-most travel miles in the league.

It's down a few thousand miles from previous seasons, when the Seahawks had one more road than home game in 2023 and a game in Munich, Germany, during the 2022 season.

The team's total miles flown in the 2024 season doesn't count Seattle's road games in the preseason, during August. Those will be announced soon.

WSU football games to be televised by The CW, Fox

Washington State's football games for next season have a pair of television homes.

The Cougars' 2024 home games will be broadcast on The CW and Fox, according to a release published Tuesday, including six on The CW and one on Fox/FS1.

They're playing a schedule-heavy season with West Conference opponents as part of a scheduling agreement with WSU and Oregon State attempt to rebuild the Pac-12.

WSU's six games on The CW include Aug. 31 against Portland State (noon kickoff), Sept. 20 against San Jose State (7 p.m.), Oct. 19 against Hawaii (12:30 p.m. or 7 p.m.), Nov. 9 against Utah State (12:30 p.m. or 7 p.m.), Nov. 23 at Oregon State (3:30 p.m.), and Nov. 30 against Wyoming (3:30 p.m.).

WSU's game against San Jose State was moved up a day, to a Friday. Kickoff times and TV assignments for WSU's remaining games will be announced later, according to a release. For the Cougars' games against Utah State and Hawaii, kickoff times will be announced no later than 12 days prior to game day.

"We are excited to partner with The CW and Fox to broadcast Cougar Football nationally for the upcoming 2024 season," WSU Athletics Director Anne McCoy said via release. "Having WSU in

100% of the homes across the country will amplify the exposure of our student-athletes and program, and grow the connection with our fans and alumni. Additionally, the partnership provides for nearly all home game times to be set in the spring, allowing our fanbase to plan their fall weekends around Cougar football."

Washington State and Oregon State, the two Pac-12 leftovers left behind in conference realignment, are using a two-year grace period allowed by the NCAA to try to rebuild the conference. Neither team is eligible for the Mountain West title next season, as they are not operating as affiliate members, only playing MWC teams as part of a scheduling agreement.

Celtics oust Cavs, advance to Eastern Conference finals

The Boston Celtics are in a familiar place.

The Celtics advanced to the Eastern Conference finals for the third straight year — and the sixth time in the past eight seasons — by dispatching the visiting Cleveland Cavaliers 113-98 in Game 5 of the Eastern Conference semifinals Wednesday night.

Top-seeded Boston won the best-of-seven series 4-1 and will face either the Indiana Pacers or the New York Knicks for the Eastern Conference title. Second-seeded New York

leads sixth-seeded Indiana 3-2 in a series that will continue with Game 6 on Friday night in Indianapolis.

"It's a blessing, honestly, to be a part of winning," Boston's Jaylen Brown said. "It's been a great journey so far, but we're not done yet. We just have to keep going."

Al Horford had 22 points and 15 rebounds during the Wednesday victory.

"(Horford) made shots, and he's a winner," Cleveland coach J.B. Bickerstaff said. "I can't say enough about the way he played tonight. Just watching him

chase down loose balls and make extra-off plays. He understood the moment and has the ability on both ends of the floor to impact winning at a high level with little things — knowing who he is. Understanding his role."

Jayson Tatum added 25 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists for Boston. The Celtics led by three points early in the fourth quarter but extended the gap to 101-87 on a Tatum 3-pointer with 6:45 to play. The Cavaliers didn't threaten after that.

The Celtics have a 7-0 record in the playoffs this season when their opponent falls to score 100 points.
