The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is granting your request to change the disturbed acreage covered under the Construction Stormwater General Permit (CSWGP). Ecology approves an increase in permit coverage from 193.47 disturbed acres to 342.47 acres effective July 17, 2024.

Retain this letter as an official record of permit coverage for your site. You may keep your records in electronic format if you can easily access them from your construction site. ### **Appeal Process**

You have a right to appeal coverage under the general permit to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB). Appeals must be filed within 30 days of the date of receipt of this letter. Any appeal is limited to the general permit's applicability or non-applicability to a specific discharger. The appeal process is governed by chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2). For more information regarding your right to appeal, please reference Ecology's Focus Sheet: [Appeal of General Permit Coverage](#)<sup>2</sup>

### **Annual Permit Fees**

RCW 90.48.465 requires Ecology to recover the costs of managing the permit program. Permit fees are invoiced annually until the permit is terminated. Termination conditions are described in the permit.
