Hello Laurie,

1. A description of the noncompliance and its cause.
The Spring Creek side of Palmer was not sampled. A Sampler from Soos Creek was filling in for The Fish Hatchery Specialist 3, FH3, that had left. The sampler was unaware of sampling Spring Creek. Water Quality lab discovered the non-compliance when reviewing the DMR.
2. The period of noncompliance, including exact dates and times.
December 2023
3. The estimated time the Permittee expects the noncompliance to continue if not yet corrected.
The non-compliance has been corrected. New FH3 understands the sampling procedures.
4. Steps taken or planned to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.
Water quality lab discussed the sampling procedure and made sure FH3 had copy of Facility site plan.
5. If the noncompliance involves an overflow prior to the treatment works, an estimate of the quantity (in gallons) of untreated overflow.
