Dear Ms. Tran:

We did not sample or test for chronic toxicity in the third quarter of 2024. The Cosmopolis pulp mill remained curtailed for the entire quarter.

Per section S.2.F of the 2020 NPDES permit modification: *No monitoring for acute or chronic toxicity required if the first quarterly tests after curtailment shows compliance with toxicity limits in S16 and S17.* The pulp mill remained down the entire third quarter of 2024, and the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2023 testing confirmed compliance with the permit toxicity limits.
