Hello Mandy,

If Safe Coast's permit is reissued before July 1, 2025 with a new fee category, Ecology will update Safe Coast's FY25 invoice to reflect an updated amount due based on the new fee category, and the effective date of the reissued permit.

As a quick example, if Safe Coast's permit is reissued with an effective date of February 15, 2025, a new invoice would be issued with a balance due that reflects Safe Coast's current permit fee from July 1, 2024 – February 14, 2025, and the new fee rate from February 15, 2025 – June 30, 2025.

Until an updated permit is in effect, the balance on Safe Coast's FY25 invoice will reflect their current fee rate from July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025.
