Permit No. WA0024490; City of Everett Water Pollution Control Facility

Dear Mayor Franklin:

Under [Chapter 90.48](#) Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Water Pollution Control Laws, the enclosed NPDES Permit No. WA0024490 is being reissued to the City of Everett Water Pollution Control Facility located at 4027 4<sup>th</sup> Street SE, Everett WA.

The permit authorizes the permittee to discharge treated domestic wastewater into the Snohomish River and into Port Gardner Bay (Puget Sound) according to the terms and conditions of the permit.

The Department of Ecology (Ecology), in response to the passage of Initiative 97 in 1988, has adopted a regulation to recover costs associated with issuing and administering wastewater discharge permits [Chapter 173-224 WAC](#). The annual fee for both industrial and municipal/domestic discharges is computed according to the permit fee schedules contained in [Chapter 173-224-040 WAC](#). Ecology will notify permit holders of fee charges by mailed billing statements. Failure to pay the applicable permit fee may result in the suspension or revocation of the permit, and could result in the issuance of civil penalties or actions to enjoin the activity under the permit.

You have the right to appeal this permit within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this document. Complete details about appealing the permit are in Appendix B of the permit fact sheet. Pursuant to [Chapter 43.21B RCW](#), your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, and served on the Department of Ecology, within thirty (30) days of the date of your receipt of this document.
