In accordance with the reporting requirements in NPDES permit for the West Point Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) (Permit No. WA0029181) Section S11.C.d, King County Wastewater Treatment Division submits a corrective action report for outfall 012 (Belvoir Pump Station [PS] Combined Sewer Overflow).

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This report also meets Supplemental Compliance Plan requirements per Section V of the CD and supersedes the Corrective Action Compliance Notification Letter submitted December 19, 2017, for the Belvoir PS Overflow, DSN 012.

Per Section VI, paragraph 40 of the King County Consent Decree, the County requests that EPA and Ecology review and provide comment or approve the attached corrective action report no later than 90 days from receipt, herein assumed as October 24, 2024. Failure to act within 90 days will result in a delay to all corrective action milestones proposed in the corrective action report.
