**PUBLIC NOTICE
2024 INDUSTRIAL USERS IN
SIGNIFICANT NONCOMPLIANCE**

The City of Yakima (City) Wastewater Division enforces Federal, State, and local limits on process wastewater discharges to the Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW) through the use of a fully delegated Pretreatment Program, the more stringent being defined as Pretreatment Standards under Section 307 (d) of the Clean Water Act.

In accordance with 40 CFR Part 25 and 40 CFR 403.8 (f) (2) (vii), the Pretreatment Program is hereby providing public notice of all industrial users which have demonstrated Significant Noncompliance with the Pretreatment Standards, and thus with the City of Yakima's Sewer Use and Pretreatment Ordinance within the previous twelve (12) months:

Issued a notice of significant noncompliance on February 6, 2025 for the 4th quarter of 2024 due to the concentration amount detected in the wastewater discharge exceeding the daily maximum concentration limit of 0.3 mg/L for Copper. Liberty Bottles has been responsive in resolving this issue with The City of Yakima, and the City of Union Gap in order to regain compliance as soon as possible.
