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**RE: Revised 2024 Wastewater Collection System Annual Report
NPDES Permit WA0031682 and Consent Decree Civil Action No. 2:13-cv-678**

The City of Seattle's Wastewater Consent Decree (Civil Action No. 2:13-cv-678) and Section S4.B of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit WA0031682 each include annual reporting requirements. To give our regulators and ratepayers a clear and comprehensive picture of the activities we are undertaking to control CSOs, reduce sewer overflows, and eliminate dry weather overflows, Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) has chosen to prepare a single annual report. A copy of the revised 2024 Annual Report is enclosed.


During the review of combined sewer overflows from 2023 vs. 2024, SPU discovered an error in the overflow volume for Outfall 152. This was due to a QA/QC error of the depth data. The error resulted in SPU erroneously reporting a significantly higher volume in November 2024 compared to 2023. The revised numbers for 2024 are summarized in the following table. The document revision history table on page i also lists each area of the report that is revised to reflect these corrected overflow volumes.
