Per the schedule milestone in Appendix G of the First Material Modification to the Consent Decree, and in accordance with the submittal requirement in Section S8.B.2 of NPDES Permit No. WA003168, SPU is submitting the enclosed Final Engineering Report Amendment for the Central Waterfront Vine (Basin 69) CSO Control Project, for your review. In December 2019, SPU submitted the Central Waterfront Basin (Basin 69) Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project Engineering Report (2019 Report). In February 2020, SPU received notification that Ecology approved the 2019 Report on January 28, 2020. Since the approval, King County Wastewater Treatment Division built a new system model, which is a more accurate representation of their system, and produced new boundary conditions. The Final Engineering Report Amendment discusses the new boundary conditions used in analysis, modifications to the recommended alternative, and the updated opinion of probable construction costs and project schedule.
