RE: Reapply for your Sand & Gravel General Permit – WAG507178

Dear Sue Devaney:

Your facility is covered under Ecology's Sand & Gravel General Permit which will expire on March 31, 2026. The permit requires you to reapply for permit coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the current permit (General Condition G18). **You must reapply for the permit by October 2, 2025, to maintain your permit coverage beyond the expiration date.**

If you fail to reapply for the Sand & Gravel General Permit, your current permit coverage will terminate on March 31, 2026. If your permit is terminated and you discharge pollutants to state waters, you will violate the federal Clean Water Act and Chapter 90.48 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW).

To Reapply Online

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) uses SecureAccess Washington (SAW) to maintain security of your data. To submit an electronic application through SAW, please see the renewal instructions at <https://ecology.wa.gov/sandandgravel>
