Site 3 will be harvested out and empty before the end of September and Site 2 will be the next site to harvest out fish by this fall. It should be noted that the Cypress sites have not received any medicated feed since October of 2012. These sites will go through a fallow period before being restocked with a new generation of fish starting in January of 2014.
