

Process water and stormwater discharges to groundwater or surface consistent with permit limits and conditions.

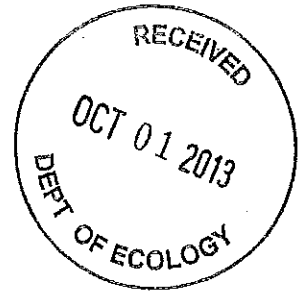

Attached to this letter is the completed NPDES Change of Ownership Request Form for the following NPDES permits associated with Smokey Point Concrete.


1. WAG 50-3088 – Arlington Ready Mix Concrete Batch Plant




