

## LATCH FUNNELS:

Keep funnels closed and latched when not in use. Funnels must be secured to the drum and have gaskets.

#### LABEL<sup>1</sup>: Label with the words "hazardous waste" or "dangerous waste." Use words or pictograms to identify hazards (e.g., ignitable, corrosive, reactive, toxic).

# **ADD START DATE:**

Mark the container with an accumulation start date. Do not exceed your accumulation time limit. LQG = 90 days, MQG =  $180 \text{ days}^2$ 

### **SECONDARY CONTAINMENT:**

Ensure the containment area can hold 10% of the total volume of all containers holding liquid or 100% of the volume of the largest container holding liquid, whichever is greater.<sup>3</sup>
