INCLUDE THE WORDS "HAZARDOUS WASTE" OR "DANGEROUS WASTE."



APPLY AN ACCUMULATION START DATE (UNLESS IN A SATELLITE ACCUMULATION AREA).



ONE GALLON OR LESS

- Use text that is appropriately sized for the container.
- Label all containers, including small lab bottles or vials.



MORE THAN ONE GALLON

- Text legible from 25 feet or lettering at least $\frac{1}{2}$ " high.
 - · Hazard pictograms recognizable from 25 feet.
