# **Seattle Times Cleanup Site**

## **Legal Agreement Ready for Review and Comment**

Ecology has negotiated a legal agreement called an Agreed Order with Onni for the Former Seattle Times Cleanup Site (Site). The order names Onni as a Potentially Liable Person (PLPs) and requires them to address contamination at the Site.

#### **Documents Available**

August 23, 2021 - September 21, 2021

- **Agreed Order** legal document that requires the PLP to investigate environmental conditions, complete a Remedial Investigation (RI) and Feasibility Study (FS), and a preliminary draft Cleanup Action Plan (dCAP) for the Site.
- **Public Participation Plan** describes how Ecology will inform the community about Site activities and opportunities to be involved in the cleanup process.
