Independent cosmetologists and small businesses that provide cosmetology services in Washington State are eligible to participate in the Safer Salons Partnership program. We prioritize applications from minority- and women-owned businesses, and businesses located in communities overburdened by environmental issues. We review applications as we receive them.

- If your application isn't selected, an Ecology representative will contact you, and we'll keep your application on file for future opportunities.

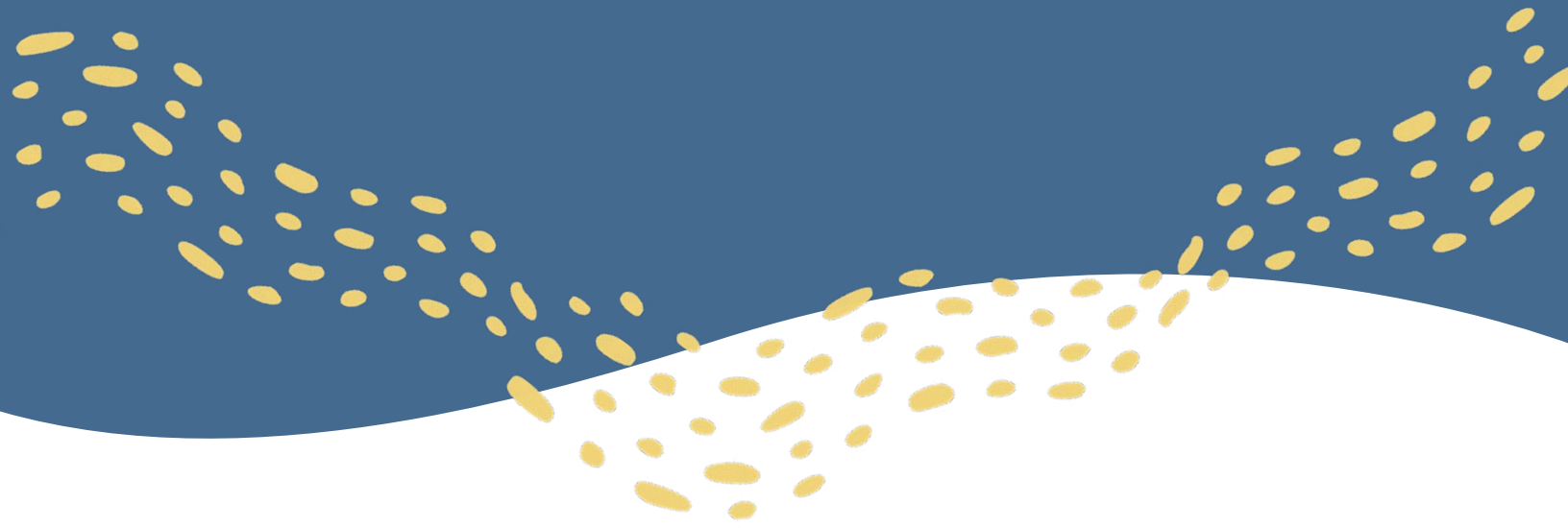
