☐ Duwamish/Diagonal Combined Sewer Overflow and Storm Drain -- Sediment Cleanup Follow-up Action

Site Location: There is no address, it's a sediment site on the east side of the Duwamish River, upstream of Harbor Island and immediately downstream of Kellogg Island in the lower portion of the Duwamish River. The site is within the south industrial section of Seattle. The project is part of the Elliott Bay/Duwamish Restoration Program (EBDRP). The program is the result of a 1991 legal settlement reached by the City of Seattle and King County (then the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle, or Metro) with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration(NOAA).

This 7-acre sediment cleanup was completed in March 2004. In the early stages of the cleanup, actions by the contractor dredging in the highly contaminated southwest part of the site caused excessive contaminated dredged material to escape. This proposed follow-up action will address that problem.

The settlement projects include sediment remediation, habitat development and improvements, and pollution source-control measures. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology), Suquamish Tribe, Muckleshoot Tribe, NOAA, City of Seattle and King County administer the program and make up the EBDRP Panel.

☐ Proposed Delisting from Hazardous Sites List Available for Public Review & Comment – The Swant Property, located at the southwest corner of Rose Street and Myra Road, Walla Walla, Walla Walla County

The Washington State Department of Ecology plans to remove the Swant property from the Hazardous Sites List. This list contains names of sites throughout the state ranked on a scale of one to five. A rank of one represents the greatest potential threat to human health and the environment; five represents the least potential threat. This site ranked a two because of petroleum contamination in soil and groundwater.

The site consists of two vacant lots. The southern lot had a residence that was demolished; the northern lot had a retail gasoline station that operated for approximately five years during the late 1960s and early 1970s. The station was closed and left vacant until 1978 when the building was demolished and underground storage tanks were removed. The property is currently undeveloped.

Removal of this site from the Hazardous Sites List is based on review of the Final Independent Cleanup Report submitted to Ecology in September 2003 under the Voluntary Cleanup Program. Based on cleanup completed and outlined in this report and supporting documents, Ecology has concluded:

- The site no longer represents a threat to human health and/or the environment;
- Cleanup actions conducted at the site satisfy the intent of the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) and;
- NO FURTHER ACTION is needed.

☐ Ecology Proposes Delisting Outlook Elementary School From the Hazardous Sites List

- Public Review and Comments Are Invited

This site is located at 3800 Van Belle Road in Outlook, Washington and is currently an active public school within the Sunnyside School District. It is surrounded primarily by agricultural areas and several residences to the east, west, and north.

During July 1990, a 10,000-gallon heating oil underground storage tank (UST) was removed. During this removal, a smaller (200-gallon) heating oil UST was discovered. Also during the removal, the fuel lines from the 10,000-gallon UST ruptured and heating oil flowed freely into the excavation resulting in a release of heating oil.

During July 1990, approximately 1,000 cubic yards of soil were removed and over 75 gallons of free product were recovered. Additionally, during April 1991, three groundwater monitoring wells were installed.

On September 5, 1991, the site underwent a Site Hazard Assessment (SHA) and was ranked a "5", where 1 represents the highest relative risk and 5 the lowest. This ranking was revised to a "3" on August 18, 1994.

The site file underwent a detailed and thorough review during March 2004 and based on information derived from all previous remediation efforts, Ecology issued a No Further Action letter on March 30, 2004.

As a result of the remedial activities that have taken place at this site since 1990, Ecology has determined that the site does not pose a threat to human health or the environment and is now proposing to remove this site from the Hazardous Sites List.

☐ Negotiations for Agreed Order beginning for former USG Corporation/Thermafiber Plant site, Tacoma

The Department of Ecology, Southwest Regional Office has entered into negotiations with the Port of Tacoma (land owner) and the USG Corporation (former site operator) for an agreed order requiring supplemental remedial investigations, a feasibility study, and a cleanup action plan for the former rock wool manufacturing facility at 2301 Taylor Way in Tacoma. USG conducted some interim remedial actions at the site in the 1990's for controlling sources of contamination to Hylebos Waterway, a problem area in the Commencement Bay Nearshore/Tideflats Superfund Site. However, arsenic-contaminated soils and groundwater remain on the site. The site was purchased by the Port of Tacoma and the plant buildings were removed in 2003.
