☐ Notice of Proposed Guidance on “Remediation of Petroleum-Contaminated Ground Water by Natural Attenuation” and 30-day Comment Period

Ecology is requesting comment on draft guidance on the use of natural attenuation to remediate petroleum-contaminated ground water under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) Cleanup Regulation, chapter 173-340 WAC.

As part of the amendment of the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) Cleanup Regulation in 2001, Ecology set forth expectations regarding when natural attenuation may be appropriate as part of a cleanup action. Those expectations are set forth in WAC 173-340-370(7). As with any other cleanup action alternative, a cleanup action that uses natural attenuation, either alone or in conjunction with other cleanup action components, must achieve cleanup standards within a reasonable restoration time frame and meet the other minimum requirements for cleanup actions set forth in WAC 173-340-360. The draft guidance clarifies these regulatory requirements and provides the user with the means to determine compliance with those requirements.

☐ Ecology Plans Delisting the Olympic Wood Products Site, located in Johns Prairie Industrial Park, 30 E. Export Road, Shelton.

The site is a sawmill and was once used for treating raw lumber with preservatives, which resulted in petroleum hydrocarbons, pentachlorophenol (PCP) and a wood treatment byproduct (a type of di-iodo-butane) contaminating soil and water.

In 1995, Ecology listed the site in response to a site hazard assessment that showed soil and surface water contamination. Olympic Wood Products, Inc. entered the site into Ecology's Voluntary Cleanup Program in December 2003, and began to address potential site contamination.

In 2003, Olympic Wood Products filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy and the bankruptcy trustee directed the remedial investigation contractor to continue activities at the site. Soil and water samples further confirmed contamination at the site. The contractor took the following actions to control sources of contamination, and to remove and appropriately dispose of contaminated soils and sediments:

- Cleaned and closed a dip tank.
- Excavated soils contaminated with petroleum hydrocarbons (diesel fuel, lubricants, etc.).
- Excavated wood-debris sediments from the stormwater pond.
- Disposed contaminated soils and sediments in the Rabanco solid waste landfill located in Roosevelt, Washington.
- Backfilled excavated areas to pre-existing grade with clean fill obtained from the site.
- Filed a restrictive covenant for the property with Mason County that will prevent future exposure of contaminated soils currently capped under concrete and asphalt.
- These actions are described in the Soil Remediation Summary Report completed September 2004. Ecology has determined that these actions sufficiently limit the risk to human health and the environment.

☐ **Notice of Proposed Agreed Order between Ecology and Mason County Fire District 5, East 6011 Agate Road, Shelton**

Ecology is requesting public comment on a proposed agreed order that requires Mason County Fire District 5 to install two groundwater monitoring wells at Station 5 and to monitor levels of petroleum hydrocarbons until contamination levels are below state standards outlined in the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, RCW 70.105D).

In November 1994, a 550-gallon gasoline underground storage tank was removed from the site. After the tank was removed, sampling of the area confirmed petroleum hydrocarbon contamination of surrounding soils. Groundwater monitoring wells were installed in February 1995 and samples confirmed petroleum hydrocarbon contamination of groundwater above standards set by the state MTCA.

Since initial sampling, approximately 1,800 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil have been excavated and treated by bioremediation methods. Results of groundwater samples taken in 2003 indicate contamination still remains on the site. The full extent and magnitude of groundwater contamination down-gradient from the former underground storage tank location is still unknown at this time.

Exhibit B of the agreed order is a draft work plan. The draft work plan outlines the next steps to be taken by Mason County Fire District 5, including:

- Review and analyze well records of wells within one-half mile of the fire station to determine potential contaminant migration.
- Install one or two groundwater monitoring wells down gradient from the former tank location.

- Sample soil for chemical analysis during well installation.
- Sample four or five groundwater monitoring wells (three existing and one or two new) until such time as four consecutive quarters of results below MTCA cleanup levels are obtained.
- Place an oxygen releasing compound in monitoring wells if needed.
- Prepare reports for each activity performed at the site.

☐ **Draft Dangerous Waste Corrective Action Permit Available for Public Review & Comment – Pioneer Americas Facility, 605 Alexander Avenue, Tacoma**

Ecology is proposing to issue a dangerous waste corrective action (cleanup) permit for the Pioneer Americas facility located adjacent to the Hylebos Waterway in the Tacoma Tide flats area north of Tacoma Washington. The Pioneer Americas facility, not currently active, was formerly owned and operated by the Occidental Chemical Corporation. . The Pioneer facility and the portions of adjacent properties including the Hylebos Waterway where historic releases from the facility of chlorinated solvents and groundwater with high pH have migrated to are collectively known as the Occidental Site. The permit incorporates an amended Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) which provides for Ecology joint oversight with the EPA Superfund program for investigations and subsequent selection and development of cleanup remedies for contaminated groundwater and sediments for the Occidental Site.

A Scope of Work attached to the AOC includes the following tasks:

- Perform investigation of groundwater discharging in the sub tidal area of the Hylebos Waterway
- Complete remaining site investigations in the upland area.
- Prepare a comprehensive report characterizing the site based on a compilation of results of past and current site investigations.
- Evaluate and recommend alternatives for comprehensive cleanup of groundwater and sediments
- Issue recommended alternatives for public comment along with a SEPA determination for the recommended alternatives
- Develop and implement interim measures to address groundwater with elevated pH that will potentially adversely impact selected alternatives
- Develop remedial design of recommended alternatives for groundwater and sediments, modified as necessary based on results from public comment

Ecology is deferring issuing a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) determination until cleanup alternatives for the Occidental site are recommended and issued for public comment.

☐ **B & L Woodwaste Enforcement Order Amendment**

Ecology is requesting public comment on an Amendment to an existing 1992 Enforcement Order between Ecology, Asarco, Inc., Murray Pacific Corporation, and Executive Bark, Inc. for the B & L Woodwaste site. The site is located at 2201 6th Ave., Milton, WA. This Amendment will require that Asarco, et al resume the development, design and implementation of an existing Contingency Plan.

The B & L Woodwaste site was used as an industrial landfill beginning in the 1970's and closed in the early 1980's. It is located in a mixed residential/agricultural and wetland area near Milton, southeast of Interstate 5 between Fife Way and the Puget Power Access Road. Wood chips, sand, rock and American Smelting and Refining Company (Asarco) slag were dumped at the site. Most of these materials came from log sorting yards in the Commencement Bay tide flats.

The 1992 Ecology Enforcement Order required that the 18 acre property be consolidated into an 11-acre pile. The Order required construction of a multi-layer capping system on the pile. This system reduced the metals escaping from the site significantly, and was considered adequate to contain the contamination. However, since the capping system was put in place, ground water contaminated with metals has been released from the site.

To address the contamination, Asarco sent a draft Contingency Plan to Ecology in June 2001, as required by the 1992 Enforcement Order. The draft Contingency Plan outlines numerous technologies to stop contaminated water flowing from the site. In 2002, Asarco's funds became unavailable to implement the Contingency Plan. Since 2002, no further progress has been made to implement the plan other than routine site monitoring.

The proposed Amendment will require that development, design and implementation of the Contingency Plan resume.

☐ **Agreed Order Amendments Available for Public Review and Comment** – Whatcom Waterway site, Bellingham

Ecology, the Georgia-Pacific Corporation (G-P), and the Port of Bellingham (Port), are proposing to amend two existing agreed orders to add the Port to the documents as a signatory. The original agreed orders between Ecology and G-P were finalized in 1996 and 2000, after notice and opportunity for public review. The first agreed order required G-P to perform a remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) of the Whatcom Waterway site (Site) in Bellingham, Washington. The second agreed order required G-P to implement an interim cleanup of the G-P Log Pond, a sub-area of the Site. G-P completed the interim cleanup of the G-P Log Pond in 2001, and has made significant progress on completing a RI/FS of the Site. On January 20, 2005 the Port acquired the G-P-owned property at the Site. The proposed agreed order amendments will result in the Port being co-responsible for completing a RI/FS of the Site, and for finishing monitoring of the G-P Log Pond interim cleanup action.

The Site includes property adjacent to G-P's former pulp mill and chlor/alkali plant in downtown Bellingham. Environmental investigations of the Site have confirmed the presence of mercury at concentrations exceeding standards under the Washington Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) and Washington Sediment Management Standards (SMS). As a result, the Site is subject to investigation and cleanup requirements of MTCA.
