Agreed Order for RI/FS and SEPA Available for Public Comment

Ecology is providing an opportunity for the public to comment on the Agreed Order for a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) of suspected contaminated soil and groundwater at the old Hicks Road Pit. In addition, Ecology would like to provide the public an opportunity to participate in the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) early scoping process to help identify environmental issues that need to be evaluated at the site.

Hicks Road Pit is an old borrow pit that was mined for road and fill material. For an undetermined period of time after mining, the pit was used as an unregulated disposal area for generally unknown materials. The site is currently owned by the Sunnyside Valley Irrigation District (SVID) but a past owner and operator at the site was Benton County.

To determine the extent and degree of contamination at the site, Benton County and the SVID have hired a consultant to characterize the site by investigating soil and groundwater for potential hazardous materials. These investigations should occur during the summer of 2006. The results of the investigations will be published in a Remedial Investigation Report.

Agreed Order

You're invited to comment on a proposed Agreed Order. The City of Bainbridge Island proposes to enter into an Agreed Order (Order) with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) for the Wyckoff/Eagle Harbor Site - Phase III Acquisition Area (Site). This Order is issued by Ecology through the Model Toxics Control Act (Chapter 70.105D RCW, Chapter 173-340 WAC). The Site is a portion of a larger site cleanup called the Wyckoff/Eagle Harbor Superfund Site. Historic wood-treating activities resulted in the soil, groundwater and subtidal sediments being polluted with chemicals contained in creosote and pentachlorophenol (PCP).

The Order requires the City of Bainbridge Island to perform work at the Wyckoff/Eagle Harbor Site – Phase III Acquisition Area by undertaking certain remedial actions consisting of construction, redevelopment and maintenance of the Park. The objective of the work is the development of the Pritchard Park Remediation and Redevelopment Plan (PPRRP). The

work must be conducted by the City of Bainbridge Island so as not to conflict with the EPA remedy.

A public meeting is planned to help you learn more about the Agreed Order and the site. The meeting will include a presentation about the Order and time for questions.

Proposed Consent Decree

Natural Resource Trustees and United States v. Settling Federal Agencies Commencement Bay (the State of Washington, the Puyallup Tribe of Indians, the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration of the United States Department of Commerce, and the United States Department of the Interior) have negotiated a settlement with Federal potentially responsible parties (the

United States General Services Administration, the United States Air Force and the United States Navy,) to compensate for natural resource damages on the Hylebos Waterway portion of the Commencement Bay-Nearshore Tidelands Superfund site. A proposed consent decree has been prepared to formalize this settlement. Under the consent decree, defendants will pay \$13,536,760.33 for natural resource damages and assessment costs.

Proposed Agreed Order Modification for Interim Action Cleanup and SEPA Documents for Public Review and Comment

The Department of Ecology invites the public to read and comment on an Agreed Order Modification, two (2) interim action cleanup work plans, and a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) determination of non-significance. The proposed interim action cleanup will remove PCB contaminated freshwater sediments from Powder Mill Creek to

prevent further downstream migration to less contaminated areas of the creek. In addition, source area trichloroethylene (TCE) contaminated groundwater within Powder Mill Gulch will be remediated by in-situ heating and vapor extraction. The in-situ heating and vapor extraction will involve subsurface heating and collection of TCE vapors to maximize removal of subsurface TCE.

The Department of Ecology is the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) lead agency for cleanup decisions at Boeing Everett. After evaluating relevant information, Ecology determined that the proposed interim action cleanup will not have a significant adverse environmental impact and has thus issued a determination of non-significance (DNS). The DNS and SEPA checklist are included for public comment.

*Agreed Order Documents Available for
Public Review and Comment*

Ecology, the Port of Bellingham (Port), and the City of Bellingham (City) are proposing an agreed order to implement a remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) at the Central Waterfront site (Site) in Bellingham, Washington. This Site is one of several cleanup sites identified in the Bellingham Bay Comprehensive Strategy, a bay-wide guidance document issued in 2000. The Comprehensive Strategy integrates sediment cleanup, control of pollution sources, habitat restoration and aquatic/shoreline land use on a bay-wide scale.

The Site is located on approximately 55 waterfront acres in downtown Bellingham. Environmental investigations of the Site have confirmed the presence of hazardous substances in the ground water, surface water, and/or sediments above state cleanup standards. As a result, the Site is subject to investigation and cleanup requirements of the Washington Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA) and Washington Sediment Management Standards (SMS). The primary contaminants of concern are solid waste, landfill gases, metals, and petroleum related substances.

After review, Ecology sends a letter to the property owner stating either that additional work is required to be removed from the list of hazardous waste sites or that no further action is needed.
