Proposed Delisting from Hazardous Sites List

Ecology is proposing to remove Manson Elementary School (Site) from the Hazardous Sites List. The Site is currently ranked a 4 on the list. Sites can be ranked from "1" to "5". A rank of "1" is the highest level of environmental concern compared to other sites on the list, and a rank of "5" is the lowest.

As a former old orchard, the Site was subjected to historical pesticide applications. Lead arsenate was widely used to control the codling moth prior to 1950. Unfortunately, as a result, lead arsenate has contaminated many former orchards throughout central Washington. In 2004, Ecology tested the soil at Manson Elementary School and found lead and arsenic contamination exceeding state cleanup levels.

During the summer of 2006, data collected by Ecology showed a distinct boundary between the contaminated soil and the clean native soils. This boundary existed at approximately eight inches below the ground surface across the site. Therefore, Ecology's cleanup consisted of removing the top eight inches of contaminated soil from the Manson Elementary School playground. Approximately 2,000 cubic yards of soil was excavated from the site. The

excavated soil was transported to the Okanogan County Landfill in Okanogan, Washington for disposal.

Approximately 2000 cubic yards of clean topsoil was imported to the site and new grass was established.

Agreed Order for a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study

Ecology proposes to enter into an Agreed Order with Milton's Dry Cleaners to complete a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study at the Milton's Dry Cleaner site in Vancouver.

Contamination resulted from a dry cleaning business that operated at the site from 1969 until 2001. Investigations detected Perchloroethylene (PCE) levels above MTCA cleanup levels in both soil and groundwater. A site hazard assessment was done in 1998 and the site received a hazard ranking of 2. A rank of “1” is the highest level of environmental concern compared to other sites on the list, and a rank of “5” is the lowest. Interim cleanup actions have been completed at the site, including the removal of impacted soils.

The Agreed Order would require Milton’s Dry Cleaners to conduct a Remedial investigation (RI) to determine the nature and extent of contamination on site and complete a Feasibility study (FS) to develop and evaluate cleanup alternatives.

Proposed Agreed Order and Public Participation Plan Available for Public Review and Comment

Ecology invites public comment on a proposed Agreed Order and a Public Participation Plan for the Denny Way Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) site. The Denny Way CSO is located at 3165 Alaskan Way in Seattle, Washington, along the northern shoreline of Elliott Bay and adjacent to Myrtle Edwards Park.

The Denny Way CSO was constructed in the 1960’s when Metro (now King County) built the present system of interceptors and treatment plants that collected, transported and treated wastewater in the greater Seattle area. Until 2004, the discharge point of the Denny Way CSO was at the shoreline directly offshore of Myrtle Edwards Park. This outfall was exposed during normal low tide and frequently discharged directly across exposed intertidal sediment.

The proposed project site had been contaminated for nearly 40 years due to the operation of the CSO. During heavy rains, when flows exceeded the capacity of the sewer system, diluted sewage mixed with storm water was discharged from the Denny Way CSO. The site is no longer affected by the discharge due to the completion of a 2005 King County CSO control project, which has diminished the frequency of discharges, treated CSOs locally and relocated the CSO pipe further offshore.

Numerous site studies have been conducted by the county since 1980. The studies collected samples from the sea-floor surface to approximately 10

feet below the mud line. Based on lab results, the following contaminants of concern have been identified as:

- Bis (2-ethylhexyl)phthalate
- Butyl benzyl phthalate
- Cadmium
- Copper
- Lead
- Mercury
- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs)
- Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs)
- Silver

Ecology and King County have developed a legal agreement called an Agreed Order to conduct an interim action to remediate contaminated sediments at this site. The interim action required by the Agreed Order will include dredging contaminated sediments, disposing of the dredged materials in an approved landfill, restoring the habitat, and monitoring sediment quality at the site.

The Public Participation Plan outlines and describes the tools and approaches that Ecology will use to inform the public about site activities, and it identifies opportunities for the community to become involved in this process.

Interim Action Work Plan Available for Public Review and Comment

In August 2004, Ecology, Briggs Nursery, Inc., and Gary E. Briggs agreed to a Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Chapter 70.105D RCW) order to clean up contamination at the Briggs Nursery site in Olympia. Historical activities resulted in polychlorinated bi-phenyls (PCB) and dieldrin release to soil. Since 2004, study and cleanup of contaminated soil has been ongoing in accordance with approved work plans. Investigation and cleanup is complete on all portions of Areas 1 and 2.

Ecology seeks public comment for the interim action work plan. The interim action will involve excavation of soils contaminated with dieldrin and PCB from within Area 3, on the east side of Henderson Boulevard. Removed soil will be taken to a landfill.

Proposed Delisting from Hazardous Sites List

Ecology is proposing to remove the Naches Valley Intermediate School (Site) located at 101 Shafer Avenue in Naches, from the Hazardous Sites List. The Site is currently ranked a 5 on the list. Sites can be ranked from "1" to "5". A rank of "1" is the highest level of environmental concern compared to other sites on the list, and a rank of "5" is the lowest.

As former old orchard, the Site was subjected to historical pesticide applications. Lead arsenate was widely used to control the codling moth prior to 1950. Unfortunately, it resulted in lead and arsenic contamination at many former orchards throughout central Washington.

In 2005, Ecology staff tested the soil at the Site and found lead and arsenic contamination exceeding state cleanup levels.

During the summer of 2006, Ecology staff managed a cleanup at the Site designed to reduce or eliminate the lead and arsenic contamination.

It involved two major steps: 1) excavation of contaminated soil for disposal at a permitted landfill, and 2)

deep mixing of residual soil to reduce contamination levels. Once these steps were complete, clean topsoil was imported. New seed or sod was placed down to establish grass.

Ecology staff verified through confirmational sampling that the contamination had been either removed or reduced to below state cleanup levels. Therefore, Ecology proposes removing the Site from the Hazardous Sites list. It no longer poses a threat to human health and the environment.
