from Ecology's Water Quality Program

Fiscal Year 2008 Draft Offer and Applicant List and Fiscal Year 2008 State Revolving Fund Draft Intended Use Plan

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to attend a public meeting to discuss the Draft Offer and Applicant List for the Centennial Clean Water Fund, the federal Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund, and the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund for state fiscal year 2008 (FY 2008). We will also discuss the FY 2008 Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund Draft Intended Use Plan.

Ecology is also taking public comments and welcomes your input on the draft lists. The public meeting will be held:

Ecology proposes to award approximately \$41 million in funds from the Centennial Clean Water Program, \$1.9 million from the Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund, and \$66 million from the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund to fund approximately 36 activity and facility projects during the FY 2008 funding cycle. Ecology also proposes to award \$25 million for 11 proviso projects. These awards are based on directives and appropriations from the Washington State Legislature. The proposed projects will help improve and protect water quality for human health, aquatic life, fish habitat, recreation, and other important uses.
