

Agreed Order for Investigation of Contamination Available for Public Review and Comment

Public Comment Invited

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is entering into an Agreed Order (legal agreement) with owners of Sunnydell Dryke Shooting Range. The agreement is for investigating and cleanup lead contamination. Under this agreement, they will complete the following work:

- **Remedial Investigation** to determine the nature and extent of contamination.
- **Feasibility Study** to look at possible cleanup options.

Ecology will then write a Cleanup Action Plan that describes the selected cleanup remedy. The Agreed Order and a Public Participation Plan are now available for you to review and comment on. The box to the right lists where to view the documents and how to submit your comments. Please submit comments from July 6 to August 5, 2009.

Site Background

Sunnydell Dryke Shooting Range is located at 292 Dryke Road in Sequim. In 2004, Clallam County Department of Health & Human Services took water and sediment samples from two ponds on the property after receiving a complaint about water coming onto a neighbor's property. Samples had high levels of lead, which is a common contaminant at shooting ranges. The site was placed on the state's Hazardous Sites List in 2006. The owners must investigate and clean up the site to meet state standards under the Model Toxics Control Act (Chapter 173-340 WAC).

What Happens Next

Your comments will be considered before finalizing the Agreed Order and starting the investigation. Ecology will respond to public comments in a responsiveness summary, which will be made available at the locations listed to the right. As cleanup moves forward, you will be invited to review and comment on the investigation results and draft Cleanup Action Plan.

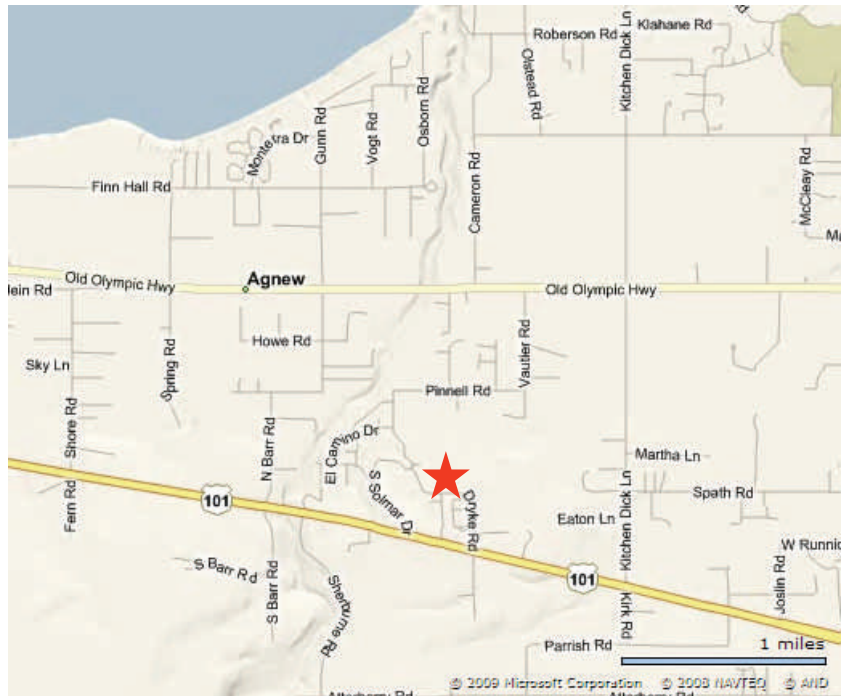
