Ecology proposes to award approximately \$17.5 million in funds from the Centennial Clean Water Program; \$1.9 million from the Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund; and \$52 million from the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund to fund approximately 33 nonpoint activity and water quality facility projects for the FY 2010 funding cycle.
