To implement the U.S. American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act), the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reopened its application cycle for the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (Revolving Fund). Ecology also replaced its January 15, 2009, Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 Draft Offer List and Draft IUP.

Although the application cycle was only reopened for the Revolving Fund to include Recovery Fund projects, Ecology issued an integrated Draft Offer List to include other funding programs. Ecology invites you to attend a public meeting to discuss the newly-issued lists for the Centennial Clean Water Program, the federal Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund, and the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund, including Recovery Funds, for FY 2010.

Ecology is taking public comments from April 17, 2009, through 5 p.m., May 1, 2009. We welcome your input.

Driving directions to the Pierce County Library Process and Admin Center:
