Proposed Grant and Loan Funding for FY 2011 Water Quality Improvement and Protection Projects

Ecology seeks public input on the Draft Offer List and Intended Use Plan for state fiscal year 2011

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) proposes to award the next round of funding for projects across the state to help improve and protect the state's surface and ground water.

For fiscal year 2011, Ecology proposes:

- \$15 million in funds from the Centennial Clean Water Program. This program is funded through state bonds.
- \$1.8 million from the Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund. This fund is allocated through the federal General Fund - Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) funds.
- \$87 million from the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund. The federal EPA Capitalization grant, state match, and interest and loan repayments produce this fund.
- \$4.3 million for Stormwater Retrofit and Low Impact Development Fund. This funding comes from a state budget appropriation.

Ecology currently requests public input on its funding proposal. You can see the list of projects Ecology proposes to fund in a document called the SFY11 Draft Offer List and Intended Use Plan (Draft List).

Keep left to stay on ramp towards I-705/ City Center.


Turn left onto ramp towards A Street/City Center.
