Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund ~ Centennial Clean Water Program ~ Federal Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund.

Who can apply for funding

Local governments, public entities, and tribes may apply for grants and loans for water quality projects. Nonprofits are only eligible for Section 319 grant funding.

Eligible project types

Wastewater treatment facilities ~ Stormwater facilities and activities ~ Nonpoint source pollution remediation activities ~ On-site septic repair and replacement local loan programs.
