Proposed Removal from the Hazardous Sites List Available for Review and Public Comment

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) is proposing to remove the NW Pipeline ST Yakima (Site) from the Hazardous Sites List. The Hazardous Sites List is a statewide list of contaminated properties. The Site is currently ranked a "3" on the List. Sites can be ranked from a "1" to "5". A rank of "1" is the highest level of environmental concern compared to other sites on the List, and a rank of "5" is the lowest.

Public Comment Invited

Ecology is asking for your comments on the proposed removal of the Site from the Hazardous Sites List. The NW Pipeline ST Yakima Site is located at 2607 Terrace Heights Road in Yakima. You are invited to:

- Review the Site Assessment and Remedial Action Report, and No Further Action letter.
- **Send** your comments to Ecology for consideration. Comments will be accepted *May 9, 2012 through June 11, 2012*.

Site Background

This Site is currently a gas pipeline meter station, formerly including mercury-containing equipment. A limited removal action was conducted in 1990, which included the removal of two drum of mercury-containing soil. It was not known at that time if all contaminated soil had been removed.

Cleanup Action

Following assessment activities in 2008, 65.39 tons of non-hazardous waste contaminated soil was physically removed from the site and disposed at a landfill in 2009. Three 'tote' bags of dangerous waste was disposed of at a hazardous waste landfill at the same time.

What Happens Next?


After the public comment period ends, Ecology will review comments received during the comment period. If no changes are necessary, the Site will be removed from the Hazardous Sites List.

Why This Cleanup Matters

Cleanup of mercury contamination is important to prevent this Persistent Bioaccumulative Toxic (PBT) priority pollutant from spreading in the environment as highly toxic methyl mercury.
