Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to a community meeting to learn more about the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) cleanup process. Your property is currently listed as a LUST site with Ecology.

This meeting is an opportunity for you to understand:

- The state cleanup regulation called the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA);
- How sites become listed as a LUST site with Ecology;
- Who is responsible for the cleanup and Ecology’s required action from the property owner;
- How sites are removed from the contaminated sites list;
- How to protect your investment.

Ecology wants to provide you information on resources available to help you clean up your site.

Learn about the:

- Voluntary Cleanup Program
- Underground Storage Tank Pollution Liability Insurance
- Different Administrative Orders issued by Ecology

This is an opportunity to ask questions, discuss your site with those similar to yours, and have a better understanding what your options are for cleaning up your site.
