Ecology is proposing to enter into a consent decree with the Tidewater Terminal Company, Inc. (Tidewater). The consent decree requires Tidewater to implement the draft cleanup action plan to address petroleum contamination in soil and groundwater that resulted from releases at the Tidewater Fuel Line Leak site.

Draft Periodic Review Report Available for Public Review and Comment

Ecology invites you to review and comment on the five-year periodic review of the 301 West Wishkah Inc Dunning & Norto cleanup site, which was cleaned up through the Voluntary Cleanup Program. Ecology reviews cleanups at least every five years to ensure they protect human health and the environment.

Fuel and oil storage caused the site to be contaminated with petroleum hydrocarbons and related volatile organic chemicals. Over 2,000 cubic yards of contaminated soil was removed, and a groundwater monitoring system was established.

During a site visit in August 2016, Ecology determined that the concrete and asphalt cover at the site (the City's right-of-way) continue to eliminate exposure to remaining contaminated soils. Based on this review, Ecology determined that the cleanup of this site remains effective.

Ecology invites you to comment on the draft Periodic Review report for the Wolfe & Parks Properties cleanup site. We conduct a periodic review at least every five years after beginning cleanup at a site, as required by MTCA. The purposes of the review are to evaluate site conditions and to ensure continued protection of human health and the environment when institutional controls are used as part of a cleanup. This site formerly housed several above-ground storage tanks containing gasoline, diesel, kerosene, and heating oil. Many different contaminants were found in the soil and groundwater, including petroleum hydrocarbons, benzene, and dissolved lead. These contaminants were largely removed or remediated through several cleanup actions between 2005 and 2007.

An environmental covenant is in place for the site. The covenant prohibits activities that could result in the release of contaminants that remain at the site.

The periodic review showed that, given the restrictions on the site, the cleanup actions remain protective of human health and the environment.

Ecology invites you to comment on the draft Periodic Review report for the Associated Petroleum Products (APP) cleanup site. We conduct a periodic review at least every five years after beginning cleanup at a site, as required by MTCA. The purposes of the review are to evaluate site conditions and to ensure continued protection of human health and the environment when institutional controls are used as part of a cleanup. The APP site lies within a larger superfund site called the Tacoma Tar Pits, which contaminated soil on and around the APP site. The Tacoma Tar Pits cleanup is being managed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

After a diesel spill in 2002, several cleanup methods were used to recover over 3,000 gallons of mixed water and diesel from the APP site. Based on monitoring results, Ecology's cleanup goal was met in 2011, and no further cleanup action was required. An environmental covenant was placed on the site that same year.

Because soil at the APP site is contaminated, the environmental covenant requires a pavement cap to cover the soil. An initial five year review in October 2016 found cracks in pavement that required repair before the site could pass review. The cracks were repaired and passed review in June 2016.

Fuel and oil storage on the site led to contamination with petroleum hydrocarbons and related volatile organic chemicals. The underground storage tanks that stored the fuel and oil were decommissioned, residual gasoline and oil were disposed of, and petroleum contaminated soil was excavated. Some petroleum contaminated soil remained under a building and a restrictive covenant was put on the site to prevent exposure to the remaining contamination.

A site visit in August 2016 determined that the building and asphalt cover at the site continue to eliminate exposure to remaining contaminated soils. Based on this review, Ecology has determined that the cleanup of this site remains effective.

The site was ranked a 3 on the Hazardous Sites List (a rank of "1" represents the highest level of risk compared to other sites, and a rank of "5" represents the lowest). The site had petroleum contamination in the soil and groundwater and was cleaned up under the Voluntary Cleanup Program. Ecology has determined that this site does not pose a threat to human health or the environment and recommends removing the site from the Hazardous Sites List.

Interim Cleanup Work Planned on Bellingham Waterfront

Ecology invites you to review and comment on an interim action work plan for the Georgia-Pacific West (GP West) site on the Bellingham waterfront. The proposed cleanup work will remove and dispose of mercury-contaminated soil from previous work in the Chlor-Alkali area of the site.

As part of a 2013 interim action cleanup, mercury-contaminated building materials and about 2,300 cubic yards of soil were removed from the Chlor-Alkali area of the GP West site and disposed at an approved landfill. During this cleanup work, more contaminated soil than planned was excavated from the site and the Port of Bellingham and Ecology agreed to secure the soil (about 600 cubic yards) on-site under a thick plastic protective cover. The proposed interim cleanup action will remove and dispose of this contaminated soil at an approved landfill.

GLOSSARY

Agreed order - A legal agreement with Ecology to make sure the cleanup meets the standards of Washington State's cleanup law, the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Cleanup action plan (CAP) - A document that describes the selected cleanup method(s) and specifies cleanup standards and other requirements. It is based on information and technical analyses generated during the RI/FS and consideration of public comments and community concerns. A draft of the CAP (DCAP) is made available for public review and comment before finalizing.

Comment period - A time period during which the public can review and comment on various documents and Ecology or EPA actions. For example, a comment period is provided to allow community members to review and comment on proposed cleanup action alternatives and proposed plans. Also, a comment period is held to allow community members to review and comment on draft feasibility studies.

Consent decree - A formal legal agreement that is filed with a court. It describes studies and/or cleanup work to be done at a site and the terms under which that work is to be done.

Engineering design report - Engineering design reports outline the specific details for implementation and operation of the first phase of the cleanup actions.

ERTS - Environmental Report Tracking System

Five-year periodic review - A periodic review is conducted at least every five years after the initiation of a cleanup action at a site, as required by the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA). The purposes of the review are to evaluate site conditions, after cleanup is considered complete, and to ensure protection of human health and the environment

Hazardous Sites List - A statewide list of contaminated properties. Ecology may remove a site from the list only after determining that all remedial actions except confirmatory monitoring have been completed and compliance with the cleanup standards has been achieved at the site, or the listing was erroneous.

Independent cleanup action - Any remedial action without department oversight or approval and not under an order or decree.

LUST - Leaking Underground Storage Tank

NFA - No Further Action

Public participation plan - Outlines and describes the tools Ecology will use to inform the public about site activities, and it identifies opportunities for the community to become involved in this process.

PSI - Puget Sound Initiative

RCW - Revised Code of Washington

Remedial action - Construction work done to clean up a contaminated site.

Remedial investigation/feasibility study - Two distinct but related studies. They are usually performed at the same time, and together referred to as the "RI/FS."

RI/FS - See Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study

SEPA - State Environmental Policy Act

Site Hazard Assessment (SHA) - An assessment to gather information about a site to confirm whether a release of hazardous substances has occurred and to enable Ecology to evaluate the relative potential hazard posed by the release.

TCP - Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program

Total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) - A term used to describe a large family of several hundred chemical compounds that originally come from crude oil. TPH is a mixture of chemicals made mainly from hydrogen and carbon.

UXO - Unexploded Ordnance

Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) - The VCP is one of several options for cleaning up a hazardous waste site under the state's cleanup law. Under this option, property owners may perform a cleanup independently and request services from Ecology for a fee.

WAC - Washington Administrative Code

WARM, Washington Ranking Method - The method used to rank sites placed on the Hazardous Sites List.
