Ecology is taking comments on the proposed amendment of Chapter 173-166 WAC - Emergency Drought Relief

The Department of Ecology is proposing to amend Chapter 173-166 WAC – Emergency Drought Relief rule. Notice of the proposed rule will be in the Washington State Register on January 17, 2018.

We are revising the rule to:

- Make it consistent with actual practices.
- Remove unused funding language inconsistent with later legislative budget provisos. This amendment will ensure funding decisions are not directed to an improper appeal process beyond statutory authority.
- Correct out-of-date agency information.
- Improve clarity and consistency in the rule.

Why are we doing this rule amendment?

Recent legislative provisos for drought relief funding varied from the language in Chapter 173-166 WAC, requiring adoption of an emergency rule to implement the drought relief funding program. Removing the funding language from the permanent rule improves clarity, versus having two rules for nearly identical functions, and allows for funding decisions having an alternate appeal process. Ecology will continue to rely on emergency rules to disburse drought relief funding until a permanent funding source is established.

The amendment will:

- Improve consistency within the rule and with statute
- Update the rule to reflect current practices
- Make the rule easier to implement and understand.

Rulemaking schedule

- We filed the rulemaking announcement (CR-101) in the Washington State Register in August 2017.
- In September 2017 we offered an informal public comment period on preliminary draft rule amendment language.
- We are currently inviting you to review the rule amendment proposal (CR-102) and tell us what you think during the January 2 to February 16, 2018 comment period.
- We will adopt the rule amendment (CR-103) no earlier than February 28, 2018. It will take effect 31 days after adoption.
