### **Cleanup is complete!**

Cleanup is complete at the Henry Bacon Building Materials Site (Site). The Site is located at 5210 E Lake Sammamish Parkway SE, Issaquah, 98029. Now, the Department of Ecology proposes to remove the Site from the states Hazardous Sites List. The Hazardous Sites List is a statewide record of contaminated properties.

**We invite your comments** from September 24 through October 23, 2018, on the proposed delisting. The box on the left shows where you can find a No Further Action letter that describes how the site was cleaned up and why Ecology believes cleanup is complete.

### Why this cleanup matters

In 1996 and 1997, contamination from volatile petroleum hydrocarbons, gasoline, ethylbenzene, benzene and xylenes was found in soil and groundwater at the Site. These products can be carcinogenic and harm people's health and the environment.

## **Cleanup activities**

The property owner's conducted this cleanup under Ecology's Voluntray Cleanup Progarm. Site cleanup activites included:

- Studying the site thoroughly to characterize all contamination.
- Excavating three storage tanks and removing approximately 1,396 tons of petroleum contaminated soil.
- Testing the soil and groundwater to confirm a successful cleanup.
