Comment period: April 25 – May 28, 2019

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to comment on the draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) water quality permits for:

- Nippon Dynawave, the former Weyerhaeuser Longview pulp and paper mill,
- North Pacific Paper Corporation (NORPAC), and
- Weyerhaeuser NR Company's log yard and lumber mill.

Because Weyerhaeuser sold portions of the facility to Nippon Dynawave and NORPAC, we propose to split the existing permit into three separate permits. This clarifies the requirements that apply to each of the facilities.

Facility information

Nippon Dynawave is located at 3401 Industrial Way. It uses the Kraft process to make pulp and paper. This includes approximately 830 off-machine tons of bleached paperboard used for liquid packaging and 365 air-dried tons of wet lap pulp each day.

NORPAC is located at 3001 Industrial Way in Longview. It produces newsprint, printing, and specialty papers using thermomechanical pulp, pulp from recycled paper, and purchased Kraft pulp.

Weyerhaeuser is located at 1999 Industrial Way in Longview. Operations include the saw and planer mills, lumber drying kiln, log truck shop, and log yard and export activities.

Commenting

Effective comments tell us if we correctly applied current laws, rules, and regulations to this action. They:

- Are specific. Tell us what your concern is and how you think the permits should change.
- Are focused. Reconditions and requirements in the permits.
- Describe the state or federal rules and regulations you think have not been applied correctly.

When the comment period ends, we'll review the comments received and make a final decision, which may include changes to the permits.

Will there be a public hearing?

If we determine there is significant public interest during this comment period to hold a hearing, we will extend the comment period to allow at least 30 days notice and publish the time, date and location of the hearing.
