CHECK YOUR CENTRAL ACCUMULATION AREAS





KEEP CONTAINERS CLOSED:

Prevent spills by keeping containers closed except when adding waste.



WEEKLY INSPECTIONS:

Conduct weekly inspections and keep a log. Look for leaking or deteriorating containers.



FIRE PROTECTION:

Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.



SPILL KIT:

Keep a well-stocked spill kit within the area.



SEPARATE WASTES:

Store incompatible wastes in different areas to avoid fire or explosion.



COMMUNICATION DEVICE:

Keep a phone or two-way radio nearby along with emergency contact numbers.



LABELS AND DATE:

Label containers so they're legible or recognizable from 25 ft (or letters at least 1/2" tall). Mark with accumulation start date.



AISLE SPACE:

Leave at least 30" of aisle space between rows of containers. Rows must not be more than two containers wide.



SECONDARY CONTAINMENT:

Ensure the containment area can hold 10% of all free liquids or 100% of the largest container, whichever is greater.
