

Landsburg Mine Cleanup Site

Cleanup Plan being amended to ensure public safety

The Department of Ecology is amending the legal agreement, called a Consent Decree, and the Cleanup Action Plan for the Landsburg Mine Site in Ravensdale. They're being amended because trace amounts of a compound called 1,4-Dioxane were discovered in groundwater, in a limited area of the Site outside the former coal mine. Ecology wants to ensure that it gets addressed appropriately.

- **Cleanup Action Plan Amendment:** an update to Ecology's plan that describes the cleanup work to address contamination at the Site.
- **Consent Decree Amendment:** an update to the 2017 legal agreement that was signed by Ecology and the Landsburg Mine Potentially Liable Persons (PLP) Group.
