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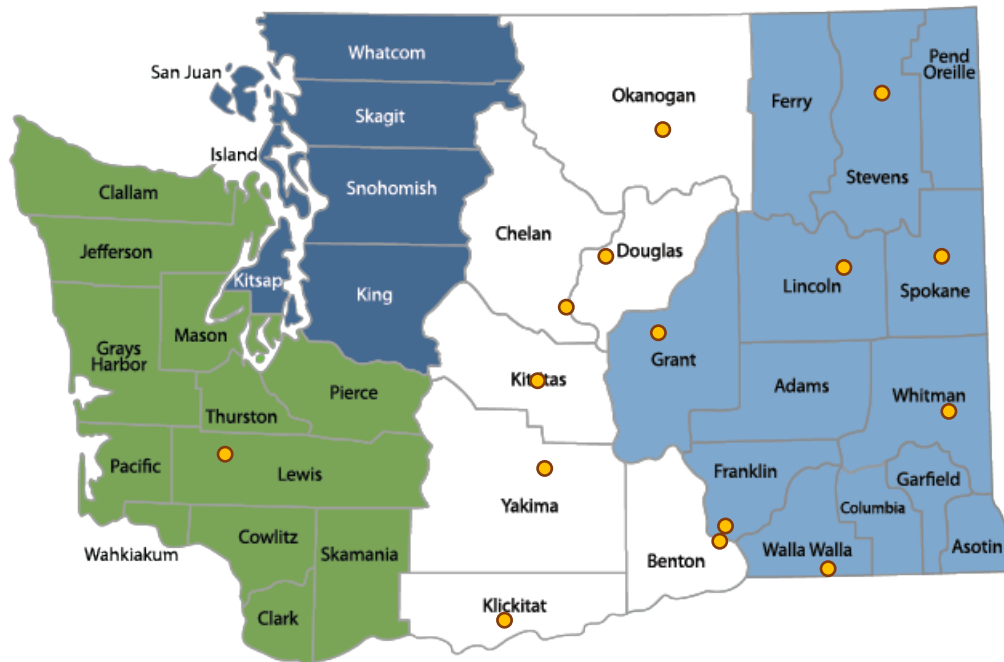

Abstract

This report is an overview of the activities of 15 county Water Conservancy Boards within Washington State during the two-year period from November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2020. For a two-year tally of conservancy board actions, refer to Table 1 on page 14.

Conservancy Board Background

In an effort to reduce a backlog of water right change applications on file with the Department of Ecology (Ecology), the 1997 Legislature authorized counties to create local volunteer water conservancy boards. Conservancy boards process water right change and transfer applications only, and forward decisions to Ecology for final approval. Conservancy boards do not review requests for new water rights and lack authority to process applications involving tribal lands.

There are now 15 county-initiated conservancy boards: seven in eastern Washington, seven in central Washington, and one in southwest Washington. At the peak of conservancy board activity, from 2000-2007, there were 21 boards established statewide. In 2008, Whatcom County dissolved its board. In 2013, Ferry County and Mason County dissolved their boards. In 2014, Island County dissolved its board. In 2019, Thurston County dissolved its board. In 2020, Adams County dissolved their board due to inactivity.

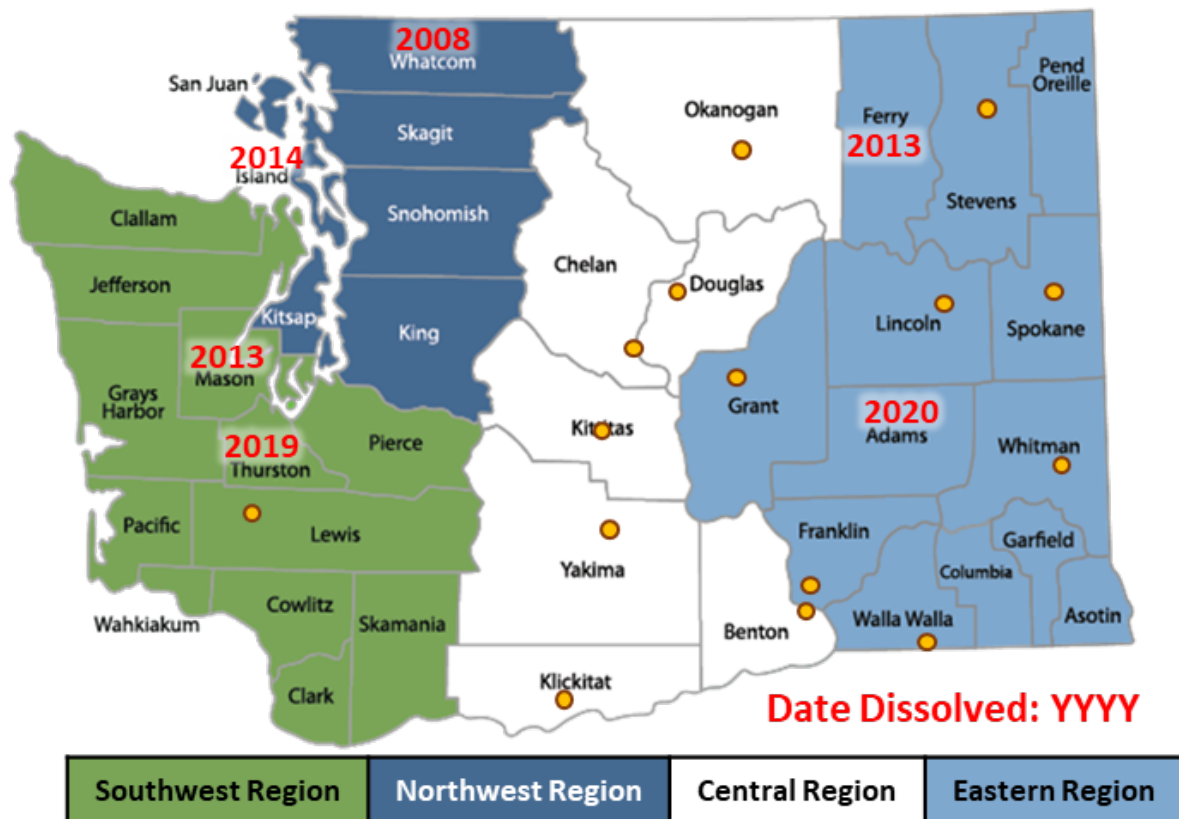


Figure 1. Location of Conservancy Boards

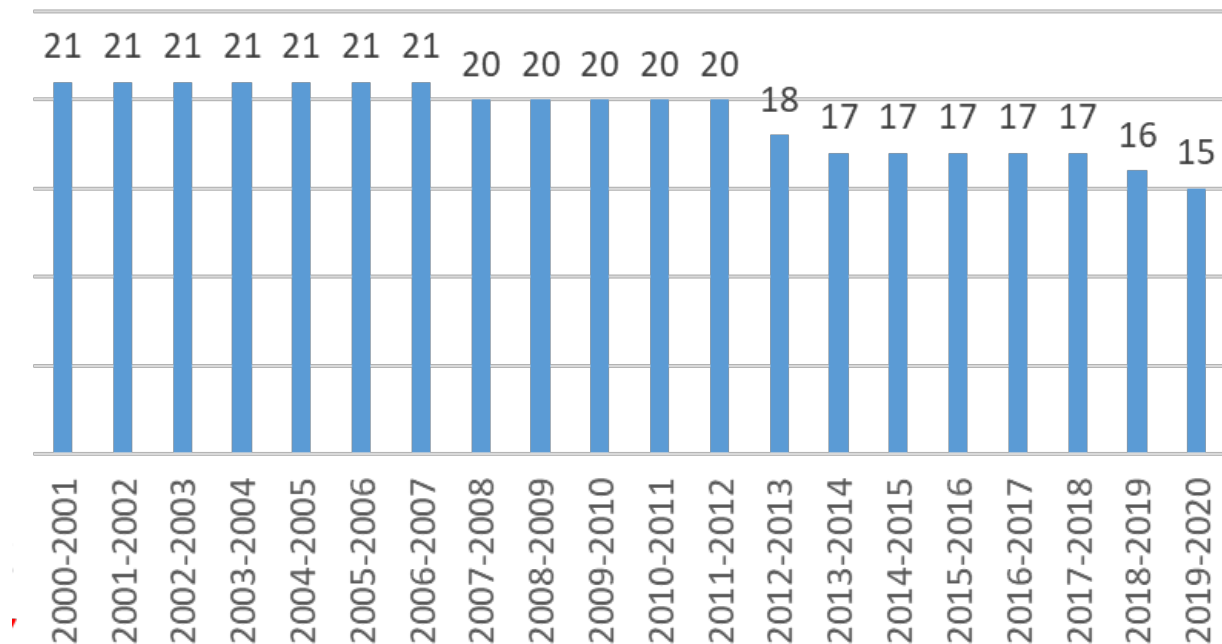


Figure 2. Number of Conservancy Boards 2001 - 2020

The volunteers serving on conservancy boards perform a valuable service to Washington citizens and businesses by reducing the time to receive a decision on a water right change application. The thorough review and vetting by conservancy boards in turn saves Ecology staff resources. Conservancy boards also provide direct assistance to people considering applications within their jurisdictions.

Each conservancy board is a separate, independently funded unit of local government, which sets its own fees, as provided in RCW 90.80.60(2). The applicant pays a processing fee if the water right change application is accepted by the board and pays the cost of publishing a public notice in a local newspaper. Although board members volunteer their time, typical board expenses include travel costs for training, field exams, and general office expenses. The boards are required to submit annual expense reports to the State Auditor's Office, and submit to audits when requested by that office.

Overview of Board Actions

Conservancy boards must submit annual reports to Ecology, which form the basis of this report. See page 17 for board reports for the 2019-2020 reporting cycle. Of the current 15 conservancy boards, 11 submitted annual reports for 2019 and 12 of the boards submitted reports for 2020. Grant County, Spokane County, Whitman County, and Yakima County did not report for 2019. Grant County, Spokane County, and Yakima County did not report for 2020. See Table 1 on page 17 for a tabulation of board actions by Ecology region for the biennium. A comparison of those actions for the 2019-2020 reporting period versus 2017-2018 shows:

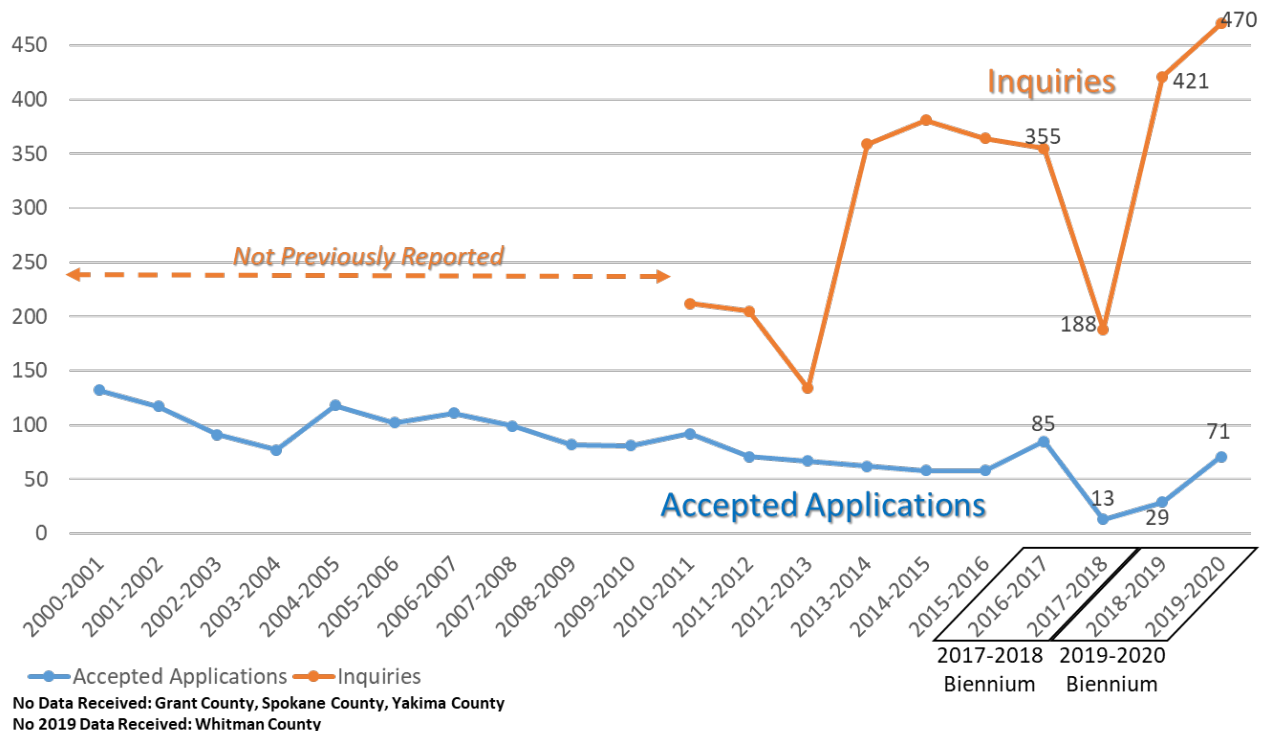


Figure 3. Number of Inquiries and Accepted Applications (2000 - 2020)

- Accepted applications increased, from 98 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 100 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Additionally, there was a large increase in the number of board inquiries (including those with the individual board commissioners) from 543 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 891 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 3.

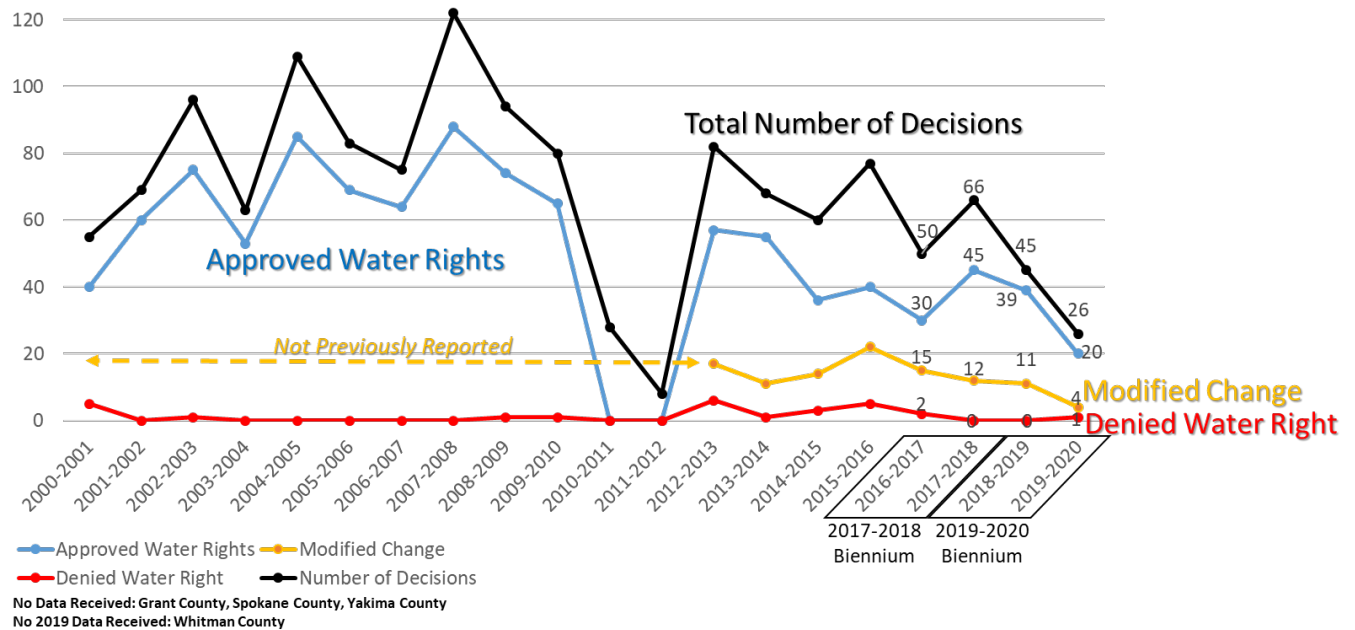


Figure 4. Number of Applications Approved, Modified, and Denied (2000 - 2020)

- Approved water right decisions for all boards dropped from 75 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 69 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 4.
- Modified change applications decreased from 27 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 15 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 4.
- Denied water right decisions dropped from 2 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 1 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 4.

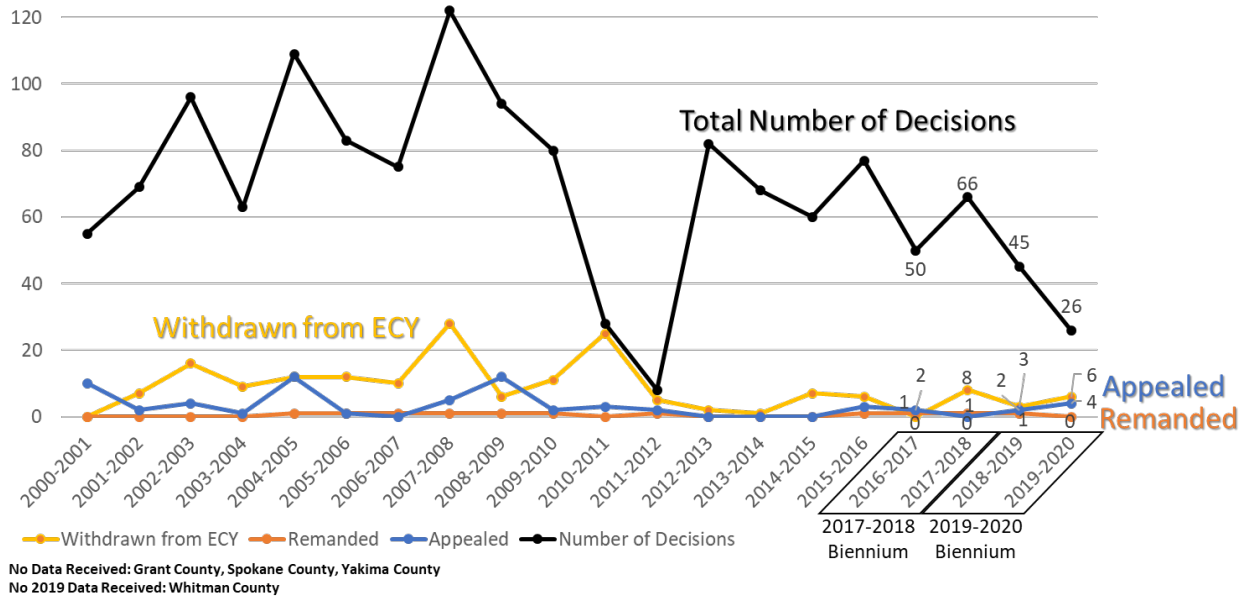


Figure 5. Board Decisions Withdrawn, Remanded, and Appealed (2000 - 2020)

- Water conservancy board decisions (approved, modified, denied, withdrawn from Ecology, remanded back to board, appealed to PCHB) dropped from 116 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 71 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 5.

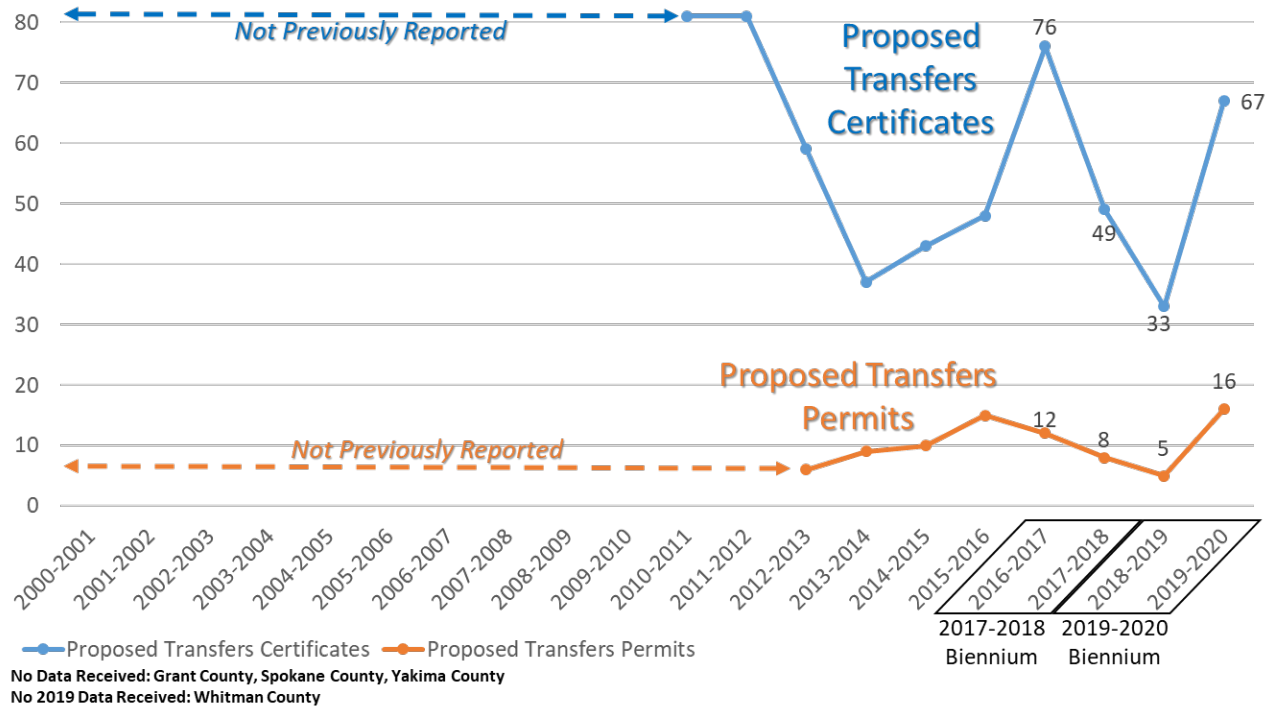


Figure 6. Proposed Transfers: Water Right Permits and Water Right Certificates (2000 – 2020)

- Proposed transfers for water right certificates decreased from 125 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 100 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 6.
- Proposed transfers for water rights permits increased from 20 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 21 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 6.

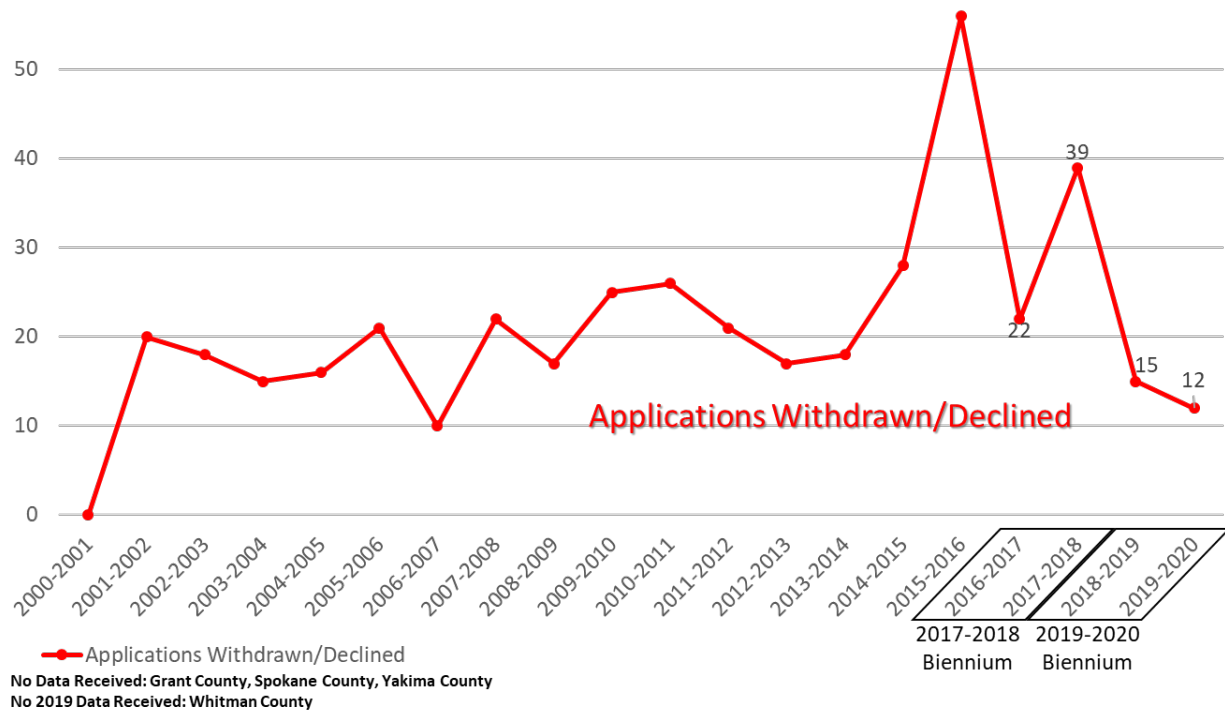


Figure 7. Applications Withdrawn /Declined

- Applications withdrawn or declined (either by the board or the applicant) decreased from 61 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 27 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 7.

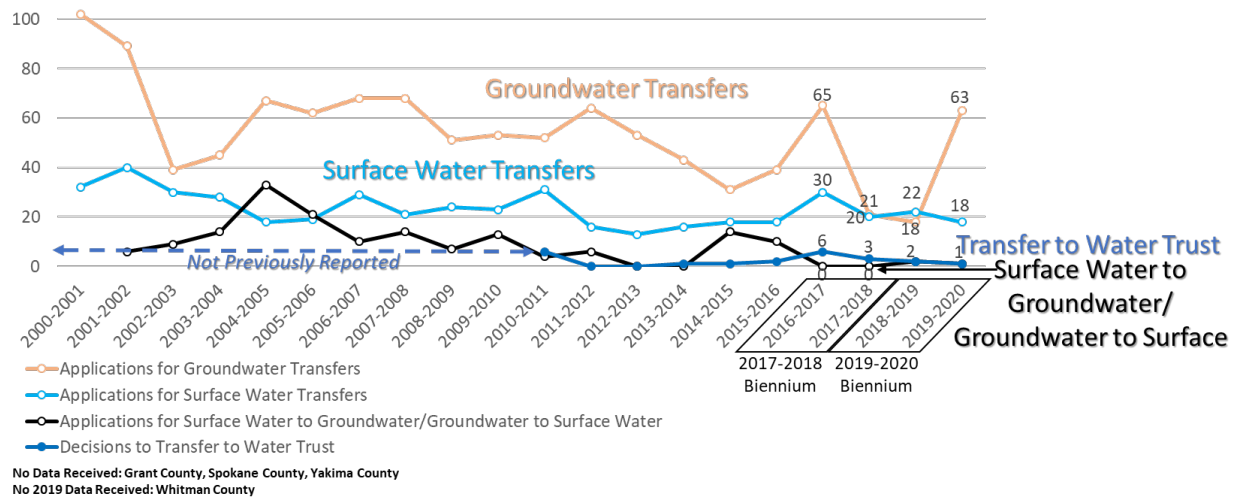


Figure 8. Applications Approved: Within Groundwater or Surface Water, Between Groundwater and Surface Water, and into Trust (2000 - 2020)

- The total number of approvals for groundwater transfers decreased from 86 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 81 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 8.
- The total number of approvals for surface water transfers dropped from 50 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 40 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 8.
- The number of approvals for changes from surface to ground or ground to surface water increased from 0 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 3 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 8.
- The total number of decisions to transfer to Trust Water decreased from 9 in the 2017-2018 reporting period to 3 for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Refer to Figure 8.

Conservancy Board Operations

Each conservancy board has acquired several years of operating experience. Some conservancy board members personally draft each Report of Examination (ROE) on water rights, following careful review of the water right change application. It is now more common, however, for conservancy boards to review the ROE completed by a consultant hired by the applicant. Ecology staff is available at every stage to provide technical assistance to the conservancy boards, but only interact with the applicant at the conservancy board's request.

All conservancy board activities are subject to the Open Public Meetings Act, RCW 42.30 and RCW 42.32, and requirements of the Public Records Act, RCW 42.56. Each eligible board member votes to approve or deny the ROE, documenting their rationale and conclusions, as well as the board's final decision.

The board's Record of Decision (ROD), along with the ROE, is then submitted to Ecology for final review and decision. The public may submit comments during the board's review process, and up to 30 days after Ecology receives the board's final decision. Ecology may approve, approve with modification(s), return it to the board for further review or corrections, or deny the ROD. The board or applicant can choose to withdraw the application from Ecology at any time prior to Ecology's final decision. The applicant also has the option to appeal Ecology's final decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB).

Qualifications and Training

Conservancy board volunteers are appointed to a six-year term, and are required to complete an initial 32-hour training in hydrology, state water law, state water policy, administrative and judicial case law developments, field practices, evaluation of existing water rights, and practical experience working with Ecology staff on applications for water right transfers.

Ecology's Water Resources Program staff typically organizes and presents a three-day live training each year, many continuing education events, and encourages/approves members' efforts to obtain continuing education on their own. Ecology has created eight online training modules as a way to improve training accessibility and reduce time and travel costs that are incurred by the board members and Ecology staff.
