Normal conditions

Water supply is within normal range. Experts are watching conditions. Report any dry conditions in your area.



Drought advisory

Drought conditions may develop in the future. Conserve water and report dry conditions in your area. Watch for further information.



Drought emergency

Water supply is likely below 75 percent of average. There is a risk of undue hardship to water users. Emergency relief may be available. Take steps to conserve water and follow local guidelines.

Immediate tips to conserve water



Reduce indoor water use

1. Make sure your home is leak free and repair leaks.
2. Use dishwashers and washing machines only when full.
3. Limit shower time to five minutes or less.
4. Avoid flushing toilets unnecessarily.
5. Compost food instead of using the garbage disposal.



Reduce outdoor water use

1. Save watering for plants while letting your grass go dormant.
2. Follow special lawn watering schedules from your utility.
3. Use a broom to clean driveways.
4. Wash cars at a carwash, where water is recycled.
5. Plant native, drought-resistant plants.
