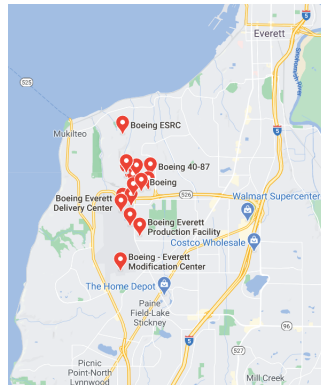
## Boeing Everett Former South Fire Pit Cleanup

At Boeing's request, Ecology granted an extension to the required schedule to investigate and clean up the Former South Fire Pit at the Everett facility. The extension was granted because of the potential presence of PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) in the pit.

Ecology granted a 1-year extension to allow for the development of cleanup levels for PFAS, which Ecology anticipates will be final at the end of 2022. This extension applies only to the Former South Fire Pit (SWMU/AOC No. 068) and doesn't increase risk to human health or the environment.
