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Washington Cap-and-Invest Program Auction #2 May 2023 Public Proceeds Report

Background

Ecology held an auction of allowances on May 31, 2023 (Auction #2). This auction included the sale of 2023 current vintage and 2026 future vintage allowances. Ecology approved the results of the auction and issued an <u>Auction Summary Report</u> on June 7, 2023.

This Public Proceeds Report provides information regarding proceeds to the State of Washington from the sale of allowances at Auction #2. No allowances were consigned for sale at Auction #2.
