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Washington Cap-and-Invest Program APCR Auction #1 August 2023 Summary Report

Issued on August 16, 2023

Background

Ecology held an auction of vintage-less allowances from the Allowance Price Containment Reserve (APCR) account on August 9, 2023 (APCR Auction #1). Allowances were sold in two tiers at fixed prices, which were announced on Dec. 1, 2022 in a <u>formal notice</u> posted to the Ecology website.

Prior to today's certification of APCR Auction #1, Ecology staff and the independent Market Monitor evaluated bids and determined that the auction process and procedures complied with the requirements of the Washington Regulation, making the following determination:

The Market Monitor found that the APCR auction was cleared consistent with the APCR auction clearing rules in the Regulations. The Market Monitor did not observe any breaches of communication protocols.

The Market Monitor recommends Ecology approve the APCR Auction #1 results.

The Financial Services Administrator will distribute auction proceeds to the State of Washington after all qualified bidder payments are received. Ecology will release an APCR Auction Proceeds Report on September 6, 2023, providing the total amount of proceeds generated by APCR Auction #1.

Auction Results

A total of 1,054,000 APCR allowances were offered for sale, 527,000 in each tier. All available allowances were sold. Only covered and opt-in entities – entities with a compliance obligation for covered emissions – were eligible to participate, and consignment of allowances was not permitted. ^{*}Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI) is a measure of market concentration and competitiveness, the values of which range from 0 to 10,000. A lower HHI value indicates a higher level of competition. A higher HHI value indicates greater market concentration among fewer entities. While allowances were sold at two different tiers, APCR auctions are treated as a single event. The HHI is a measure of competitiveness of the entire APCR auction and is not specific to a single tier.

List of qualified bidders for APCR Auction #1

A qualified bidder is an entity that completed an auction application, submitted a bid guarantee that was accepted by the Financial Services Administrator, and was approved by Ecology to participate in the auction. This list does not indicate whether or not any of these qualified bidders placed a bid or won allowances at APCR Auction #1 or any other auction.
