

New Cleanup Site in Your Neighborhood

You may have already heard about the chemicals called PFAS (per- and poly-fluoroalkyl substances) found in your area. We want to let you know how Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program is tracking it.

What does Ecology know about the site?

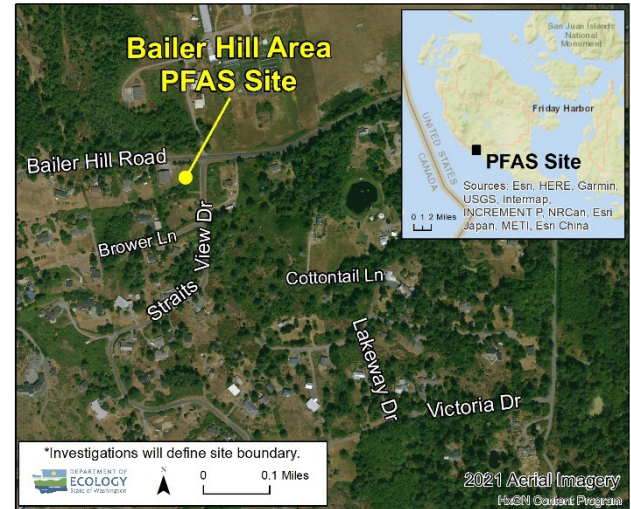
We do not know much yet, but we know enough that more investigation is needed based on our cleanup regulation (the Model Toxics Control Act, or MTCA). We received a report of PFAS in a drinking water well near you. We added a new cleanup site to our files, which we are calling the Bailer Hill Area PFAS site. (The site name may change when we confirm the PFAS source.)
